ANY JUVENILE INVOLVED IN A CRIME SHOULD KNOW:

THINK FIRST

- If you are 16 or 17 and arrested for a felony, you could:
 - Be tried as an adult in court
 - Have your trial information and conviction on your record permanently
 - If you are tried as an adult, be sent to adult prison



- If you are charged & found guilty of a crime, you might not:
- Be allowed in the Armed Forces
- Be admitted to college
- Get certain jobs
- Get loans (educational, home, car)
- Be able to rent a house or apartment
- Get your driver's license
- Be able to vote
- Keep your criminal record private
- Laws & punishments are different for every state
