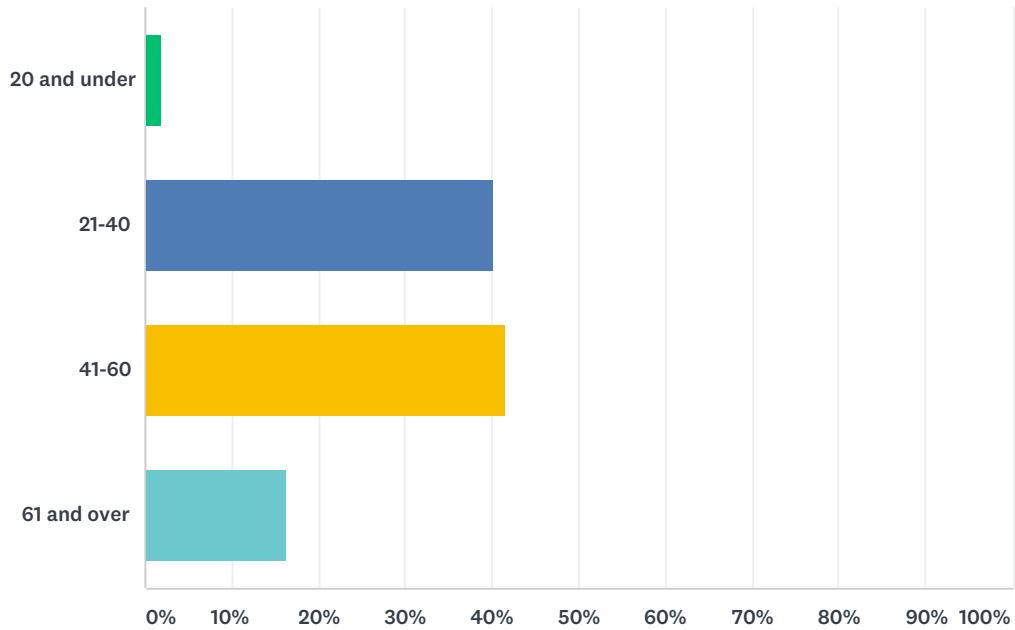

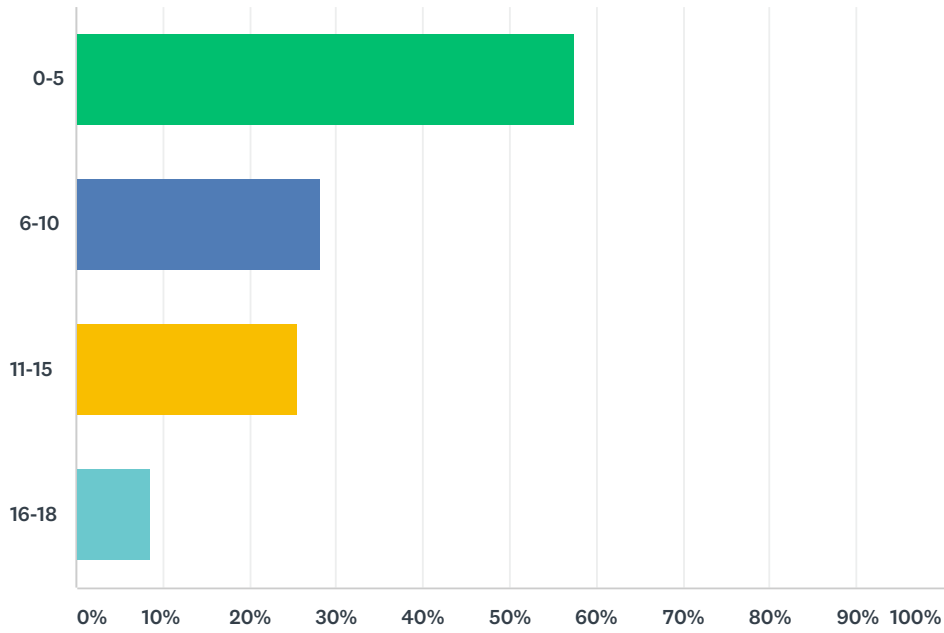

## Q2 If applicable, what are the ages of the children in your household? (Please check all that apply)

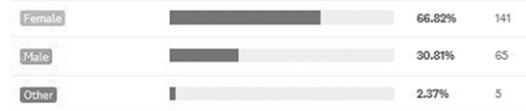

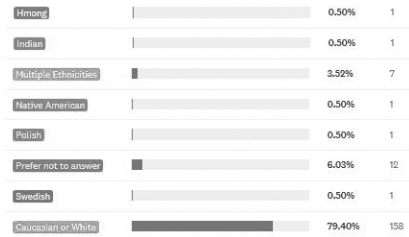

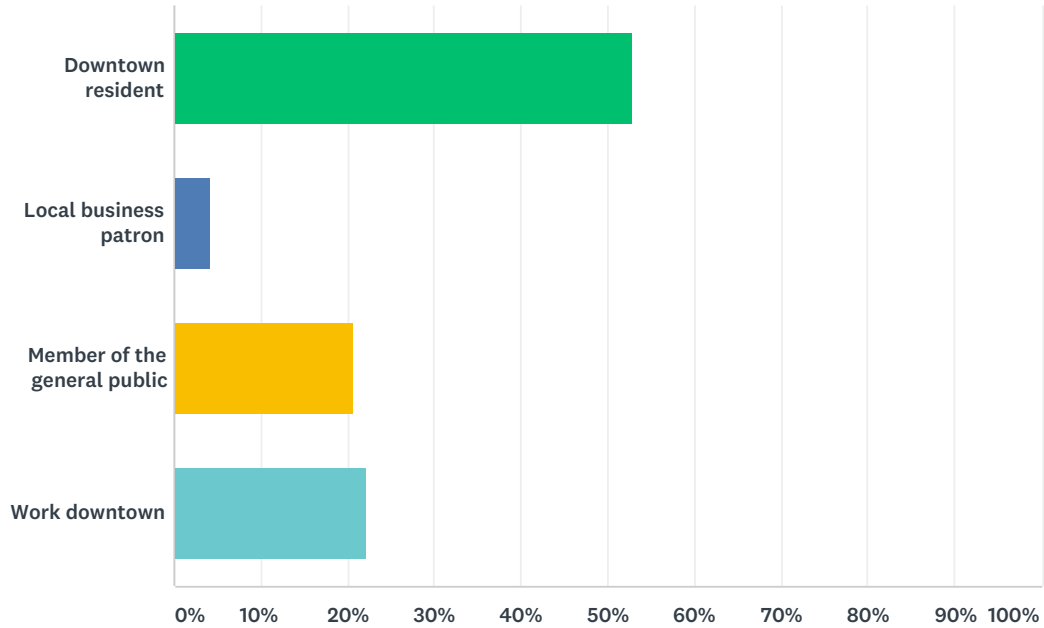

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## Q5 What is your primary relationship to the location of Pedro Park?

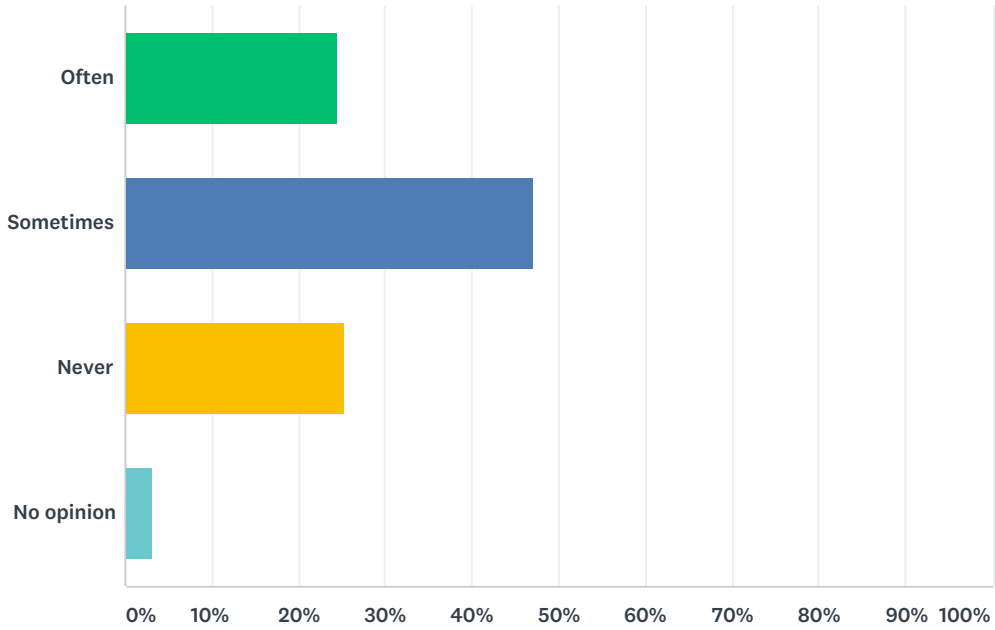

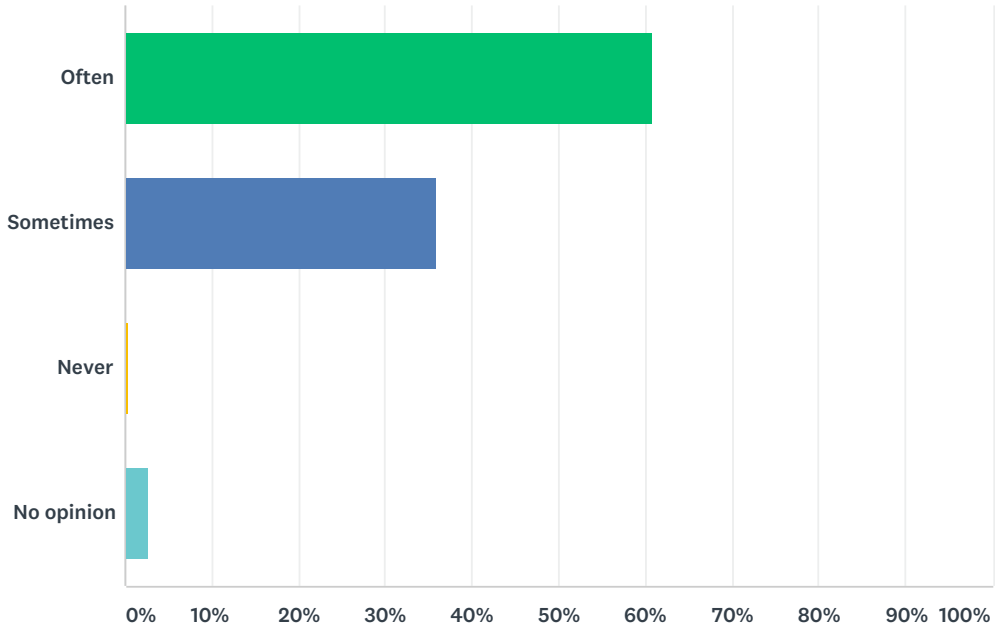

### Q7 If the park is further developed, how often would you visit the park?

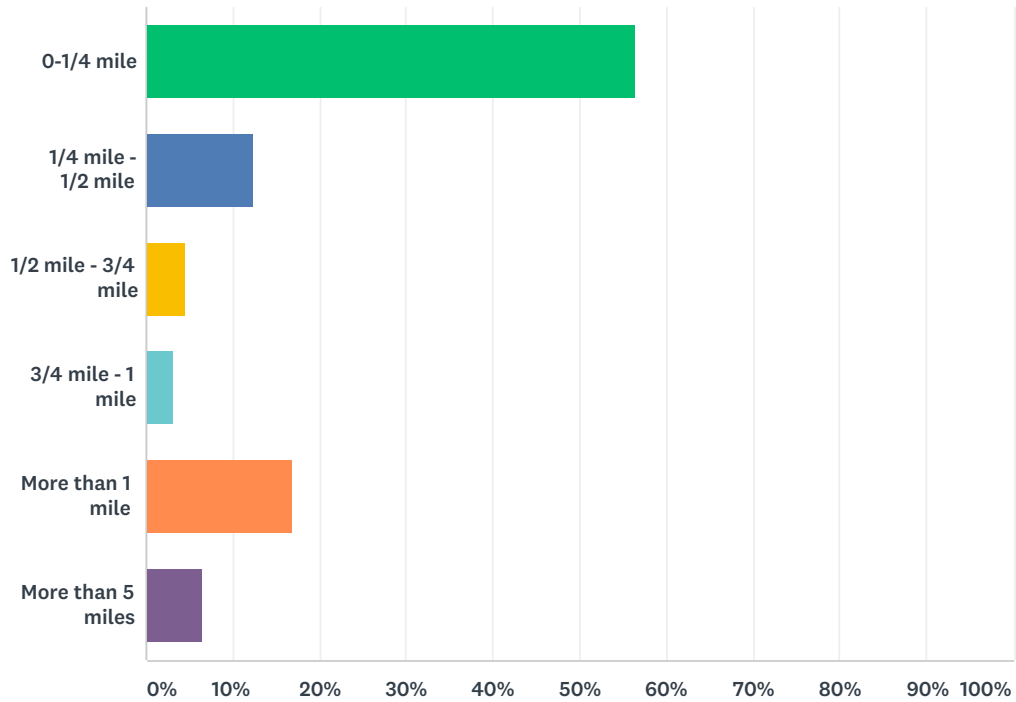

## Q8 How far do you typically travel to get to the park or this area of downtown?

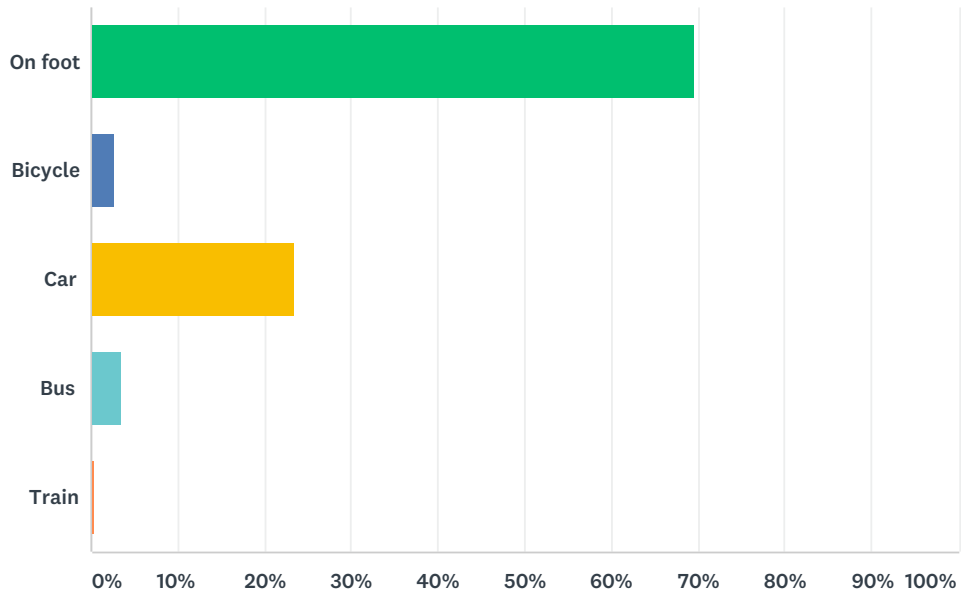

### Q9 How do you typically travel to the park or this area of downtown?

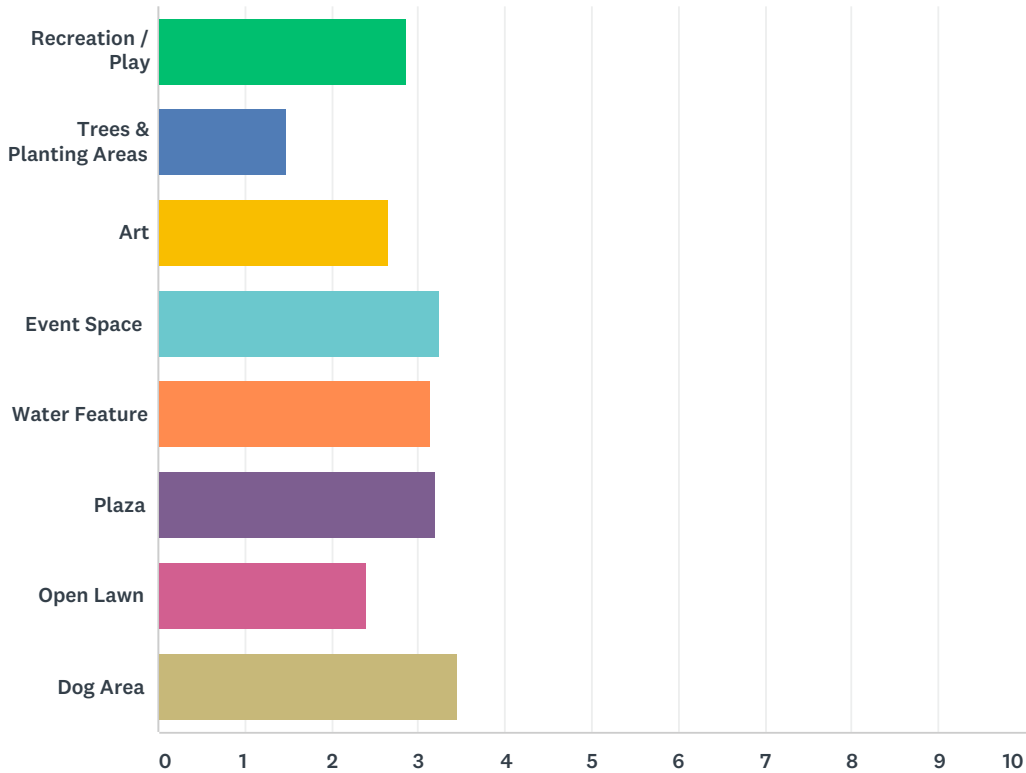

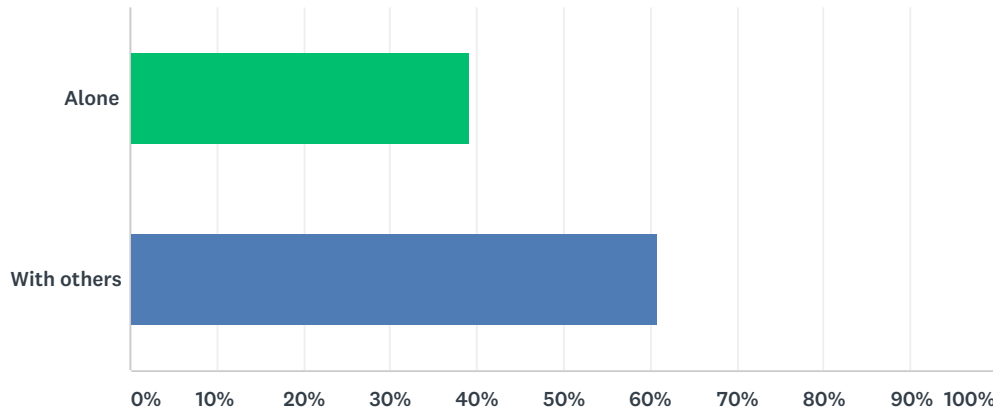

### Q13 In general, when you visit a park, do you come alone or with others?

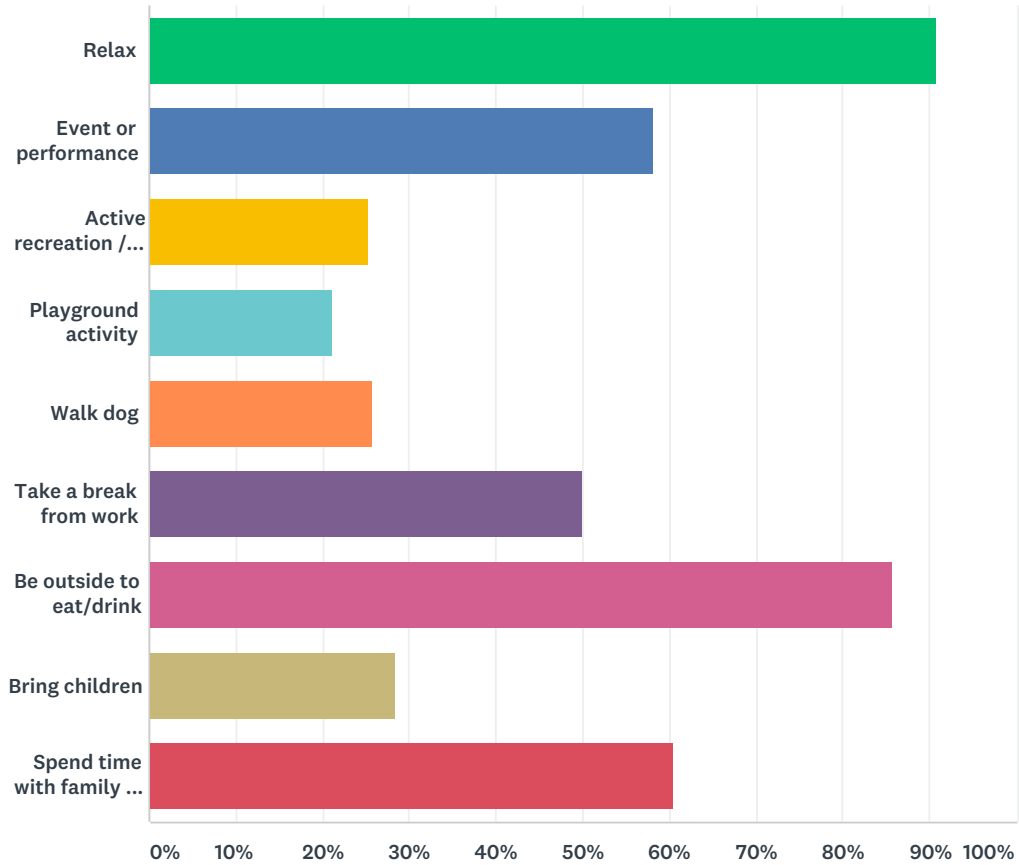
