

Burglary Prevention

Sliding Glass Doors

Cover with security window film to prevent shattering. Use track locks to prevent removal of door. Use Charley bar.

Windows

Always lock windows. Install window pins to allow windows to open no more than 4 inches.

Fences

Should be see-through to not openers in car. allow someone to hide behind.

Hedges and Trees

to 3ft. -Trees 6 ft. from the bottom. Evergreen 3ft from bottom. Plant hostile vegetation in areas where people are not wanted (i. e. below bedroom windows)

Interior Lights & Radio

Consider installing a timer for interior lights or on radio/tv.

Door Eye Viewer

Eye viewer should allow for 180 degree view.

Yard Lighting

Use motion and dusk to dawn. Lights should be shielded to direct light downward/ away from neighbor's homes. Lights should be installed at height of 8 ft. or higher.

Deadbolt Locks/Strike plates

Locks should have a 1" throw with a high security strike plate with at least 4 3" screws.

Garages

Lock at all times. Do not leave garage door

Keys

Don't leave extra keys in yard.



Easily Readable House Number

Numbers should be at least 4" high and reflective or under direct light at night.

Alarm Sign

A simple sign may make a would be criminal think twice.

Property Inventory

Keep a property inventory and mark all items. Take photos of unique items
