## **Red Flags**

- Anyone claiming to be certified on Craigslist (Craigslist does not certify)
- Someone using money order/gifts cards/cashiers checks
- Requests to use a 3rd party escrow service to hold the money
- Use of stock photos of items or unusually low price listing
- Refusing to meet in a public location—thieves will use a variety of excuses, do not accept them.
