How to Participate

- GPS coordinates for the cache site of the month can be found on the City of Saint Paul's Natural Resources website under education by going to www.stpaul.gov/naturalresources .
- Participants will have the entire month to visit the park, locate the “cache,” record their answers to the task at each cache and fill out the online form to be entered to win a monthly prize provided by University of Minnesota Forestry Club (*one winner per month and one Grand Prize Winner at the end of the program).
- Participants will check back the following month to learn more about the place they visited, the forestry tasks they performed, and see if they are the winner of a month prize drawing.
