Mobile Retail License

Overview

Mobile retail means selling or offering to sell non-food merchandise from a vehicle. It is unlawful for any person to engage in mobile retail within the City of Saint Paul without first obtaining a license in compliance with the provisions of the chapter.

Code Requirements

Search Chapter 346 of the <u>Saint Paul Legislative Code</u> for applicable ordinance regulating the licensing of "Mobile Retail."

Application Requirements

You must submit the following:

- <u>Class R</u> City License Application;
- Basic operating plan inclusive of merchandise to be sold, location of overnight vehicle and/or storage, principle place of business, affiliation with other businesses, etc;
- Certificates of Insurance proof of general or business liability insurance in the minimum amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and proof of current auto/vehicle insurance (failure to maintain insurance is grounds for license revocation);
- Payment for license fee;
- Vehicle Information

(Make, Model, Year, VIN, Plate Number, Color, and Any Modifications);

- Vehicle Inspection Report (request Licensing at 651-266-8989 to arrange inspection);
- Workers' Compensation Insurance and/or Form.

License Fee Schedule

The annual fee for a Mobile Retail License is \$72.00 per vehicle.

NOTE: Licenses expire with insurance, must be renewed annually, and are not transferable.
