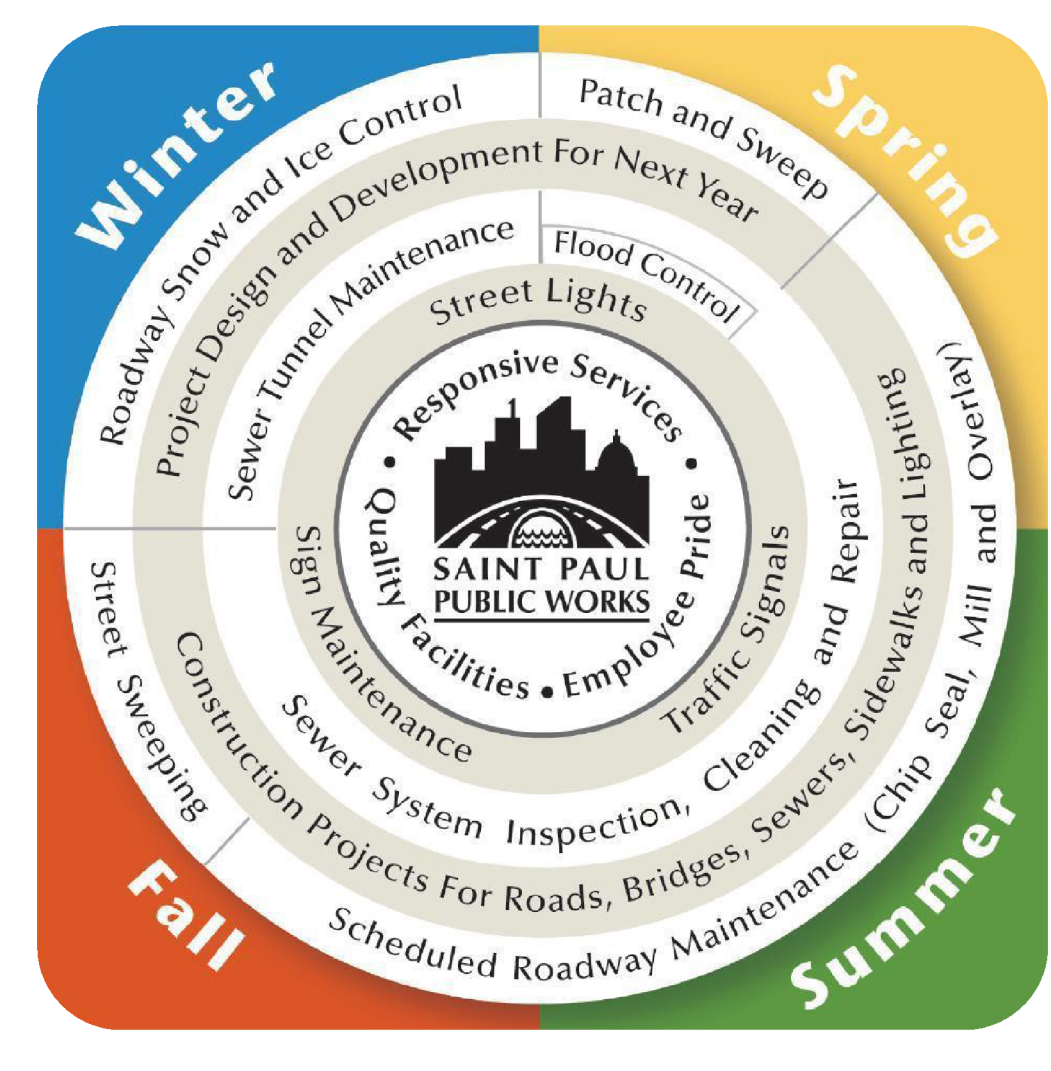

Public Facilities Map

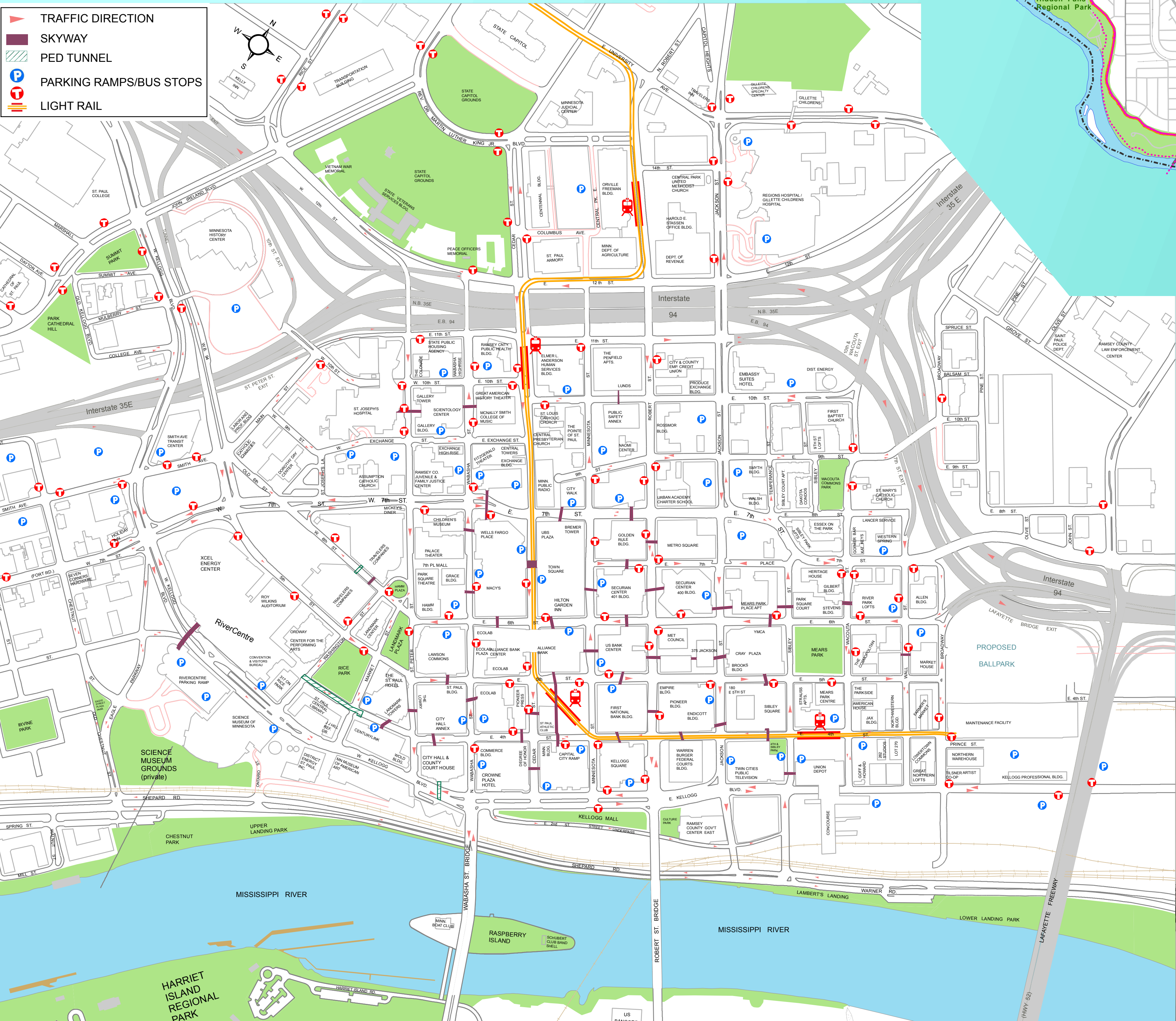

Recycling Information

Reduce Recycle Compost

Apartment Collection
Materials must be placed in the building's designated recycling carts/containers. Free recycling reusable bags are available for apartment dwellers. Contact Eureka Recycling at 612-NO-WASTE (2738) to find the nearest pick up location.

Curbside Collection
Materials are collected weekly and must be placed in blue bins or paper bags and placed on the curb by 7 a.m. Free recycling bins are available. Contact Eureka Recycling at 612-NO-WASTE (2738) to find your collection day or the nearest bin pick up location.

Drop-Off Center
Available to all Saint Paul residents and small businesses. All materials shown here are accepted.
Located at 309 Como Ave. S., Saint Paul.
Hours: Monday - Friday 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Saturday 8 a.m. to noon.

If a container has the words "POISON," "DANGER," "WARNING," or "CAUTION," on the label and still has product left over, it cannot go in the trash. Instead, take it to a Ramsey County collection site.

Ramsey County Yard Waste Sites

651-633-EASY (3279) (Answered 24/7)
It's unlawful to put yard waste in the trash or the street. Instead, take garden waste, leaves, grass and brush to Ramsey County compost sites April through November (winter hours at limited sites). Source separated organics (food scraps, bones, dairy and non-recyclable papers) also accepted.

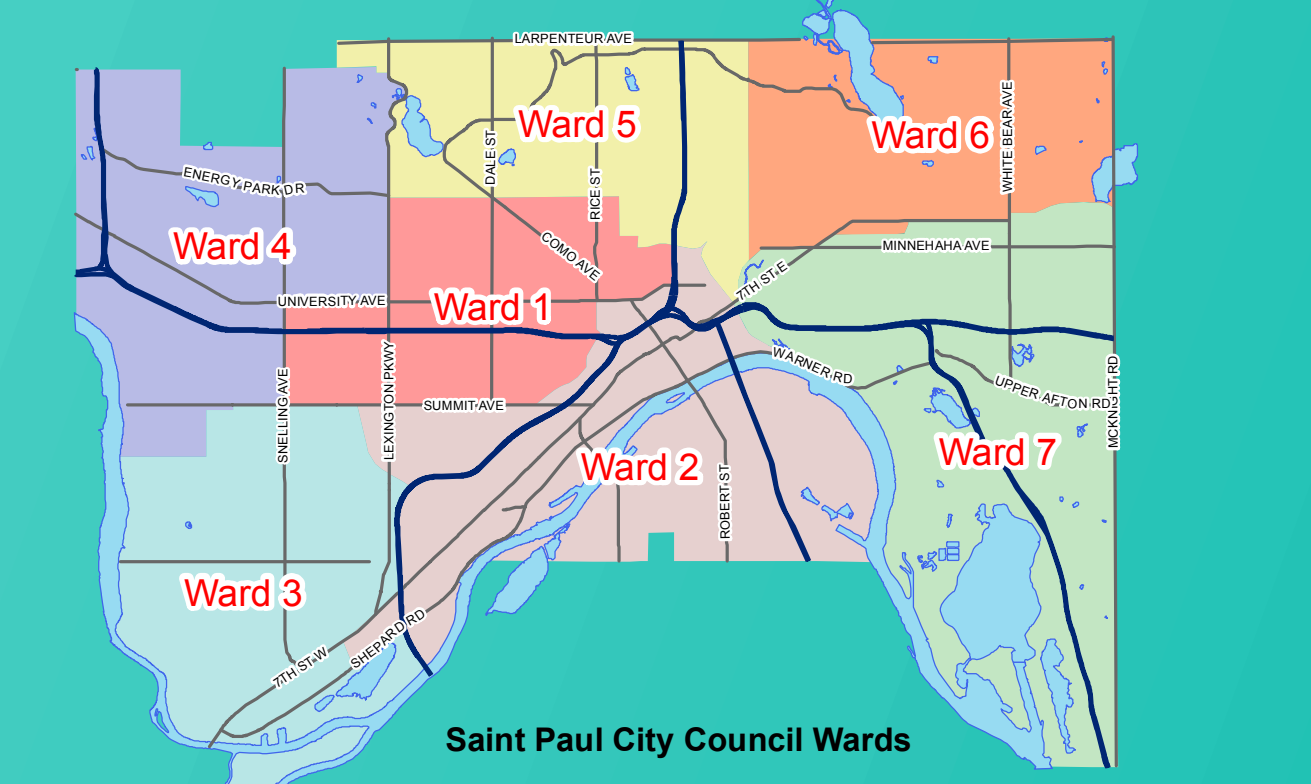
