Dear Saint Paul Neighbor:

In 2022, the City of Saint Paul plans to reconstruct Wheelock Parkway from Edgerton Street to Arcade Street. The project will include new pavement, curb, and gutters, as well as lighting improvements, trees and landscaping. It will also be a chance to complete the portion of the Saint Paul Grand Round between Edgerton and Arcade by installing a shared use path on the existing median.

To improve safety for people biking and walking on Wheelock, the project plans to close the median intersections at Greenbrier Street, Walsh Street (east leg), and Weide Street. Closing these will provide an uninterrupted shared use path for people on the median and eliminate conflicts with drivers crossing the shared use path. Drivers will still have north/south thru access at N Walsh Street/Arlington Avenue, as well as eastbound and westbound access on Wheelock. 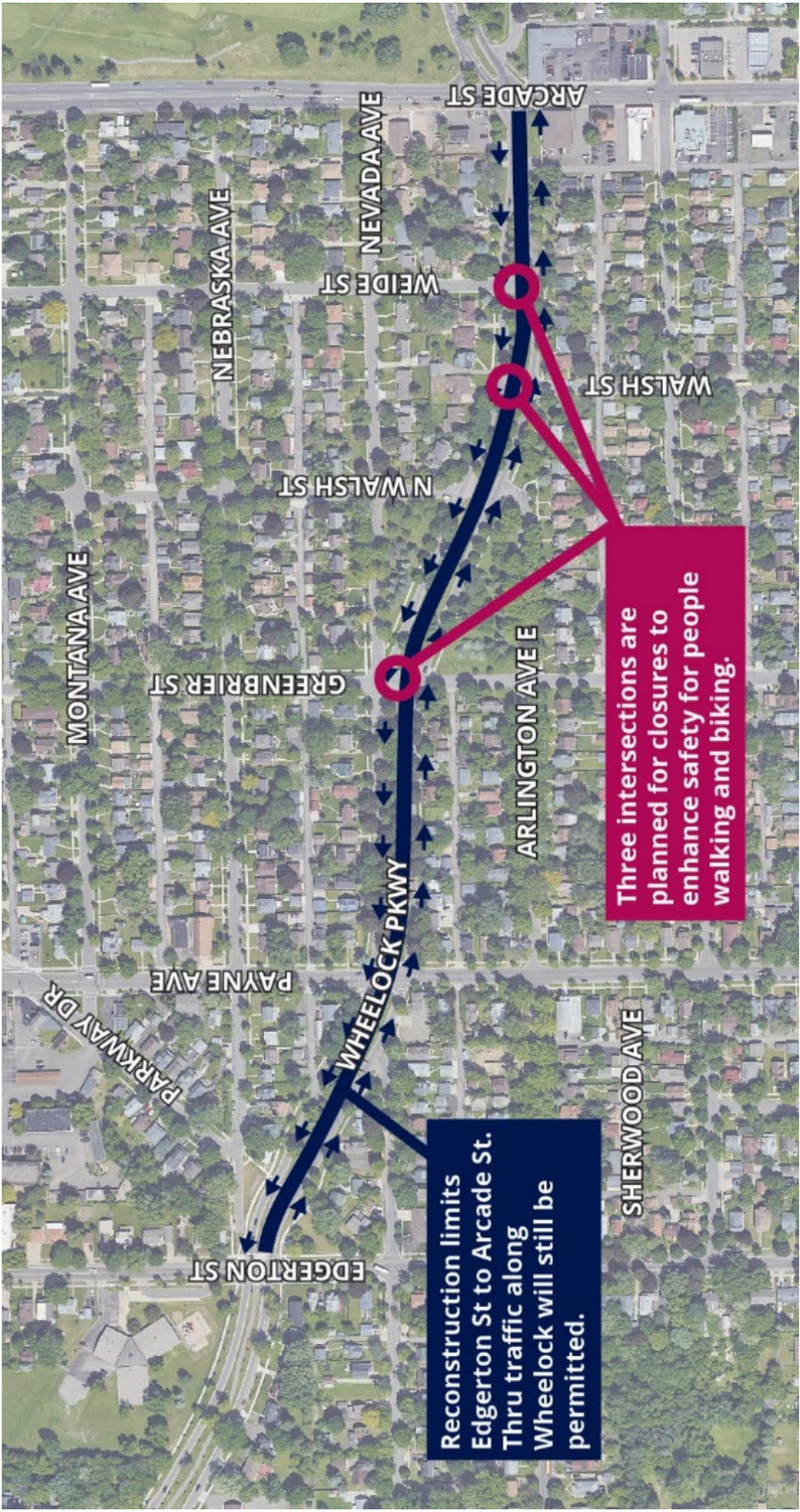
