
Pleasant Avenue Reconstruction 2025



Timeline & Current Pleasant Avenue







Additionally, freezing and thawing of water wears the pavement quicker.




Water pooling near the road and the steep slope to the north requires maintenance frequently during freeze events in the winter.



Existing and Missing Sidewalks


Pleasant Avenue is currently a sidewalk gap in the network.






Existing and Planned Bike Routes



Existing Typical Cross Section









