IV. New Business:

A.	Applicant - Location - Zoning - Purpose: <u>Administrative Review</u>	Darius Husain 792 Rose Avenue East H2 The appellant operates a grade 9-12 school called Face to Face Academy out of a leased space in a building on the adjoining lot. The school purchased this vacant lot to utilize it for their outdoor activities. Their contractor applied for a fence plan review to install an opaque 6’ tall fence along Rose Avenue East and the western property line of this vacant lot. The Zoning Administrator denied this request, as the use proposed is determined to be accessory to the school and an accessory use is not acceptable as a primary use. The lot could be combined with the school building parcel in order to remedy this situation. The appellant contends that the activities on the vacant lot are primary uses, and a lot combination is not necessary. <b>Approved</b>	<b>(24-022465)</b>          <b>5-1</b>
