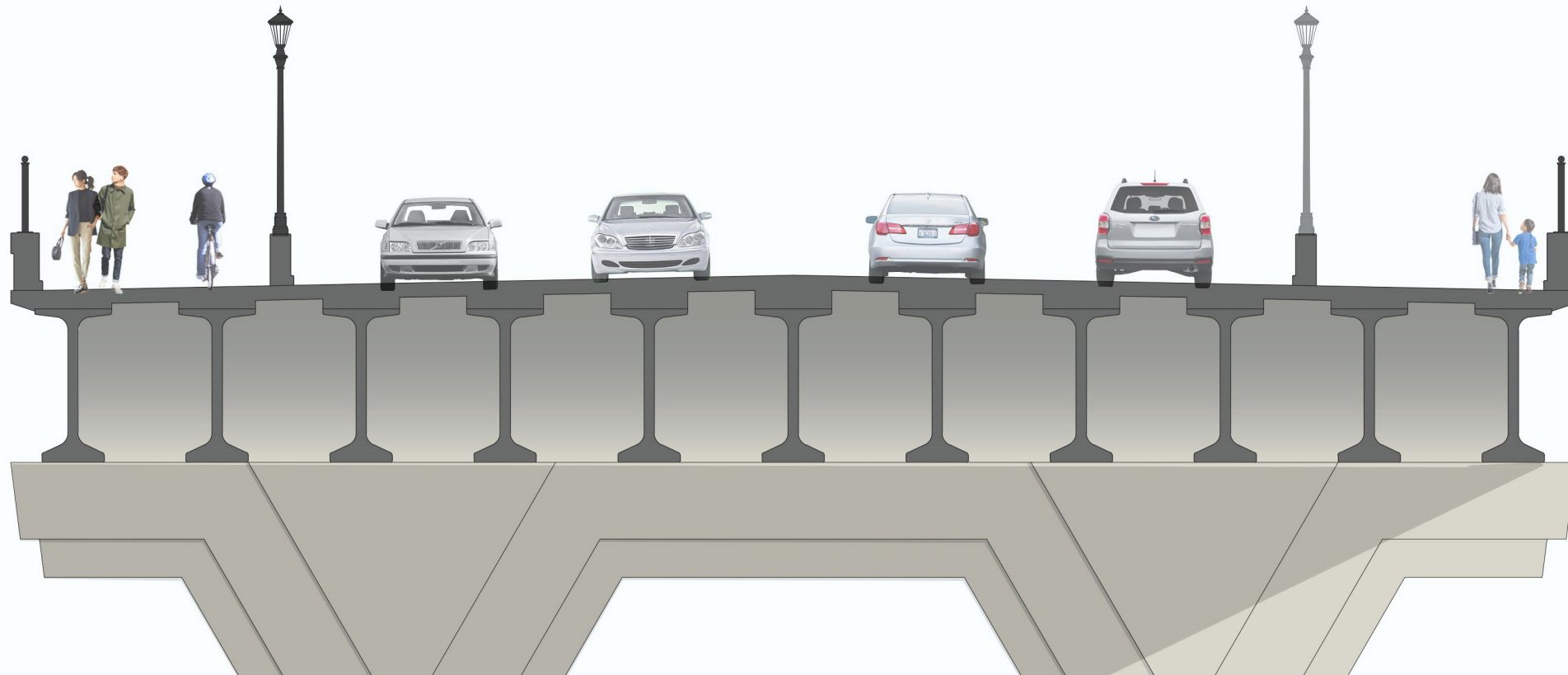
NEW BRIDGE DESIGN - PROJECT LIMITS





NEW BRIDGE DESIGN – DECK LAYOUT

- Barrier-protected 12 foot wide shared-use trail on each side
- Two vehicle lanes in each direction
- Taller concrete beams (longer spans)

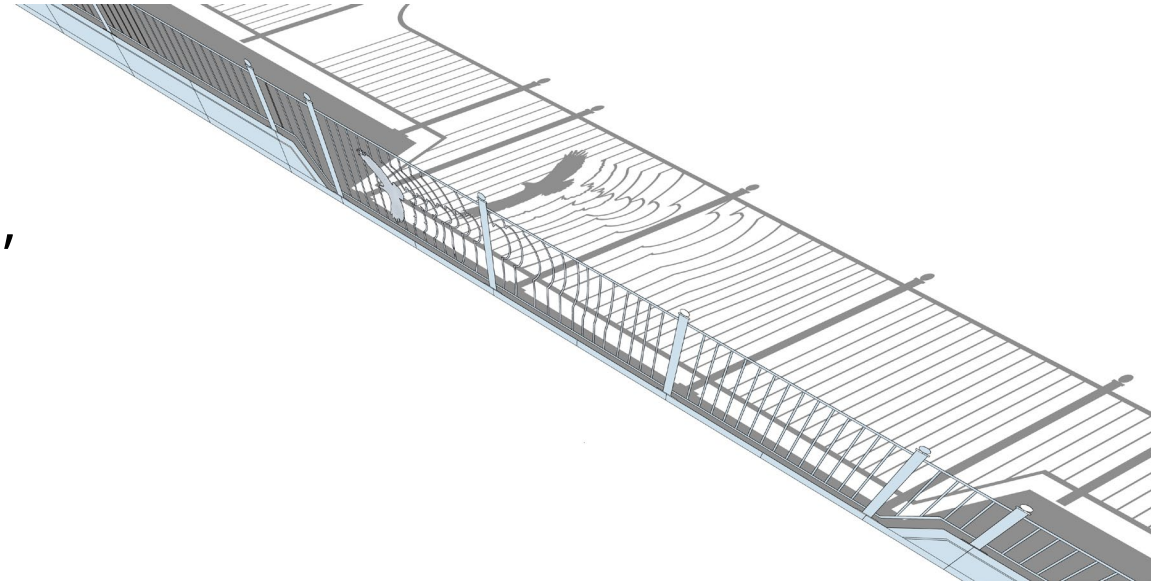




NEW BRIDGE DESIGN – ART & AESTHETICS

Above (on the bridge deck)

- Custom railing sections, with artistic designs inspired by public participation, will add interest and cast dynamic shadows on bridge sidewalks.

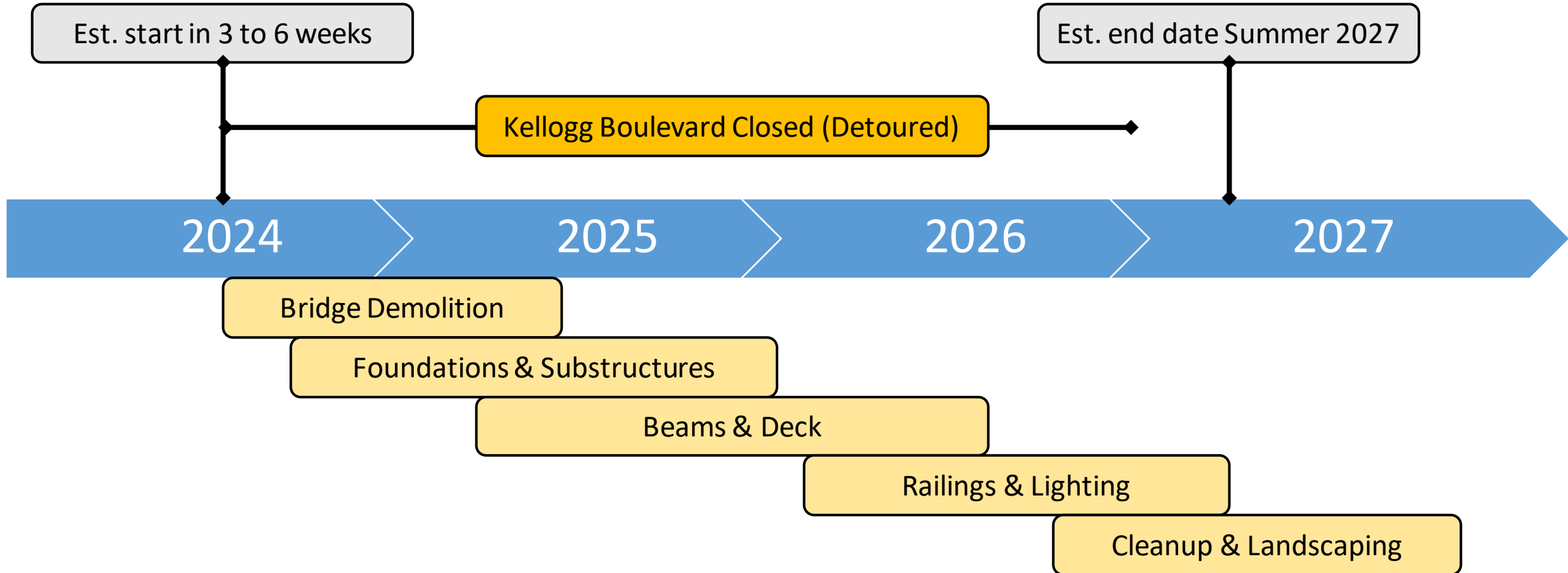


Below (under the bridge)

- Subtle patterns, cast into the concrete bridge supports, will evoke the Lakota theme of “Kapemni”, a mirroring symbol reflecting intertwining and balance in the universe.

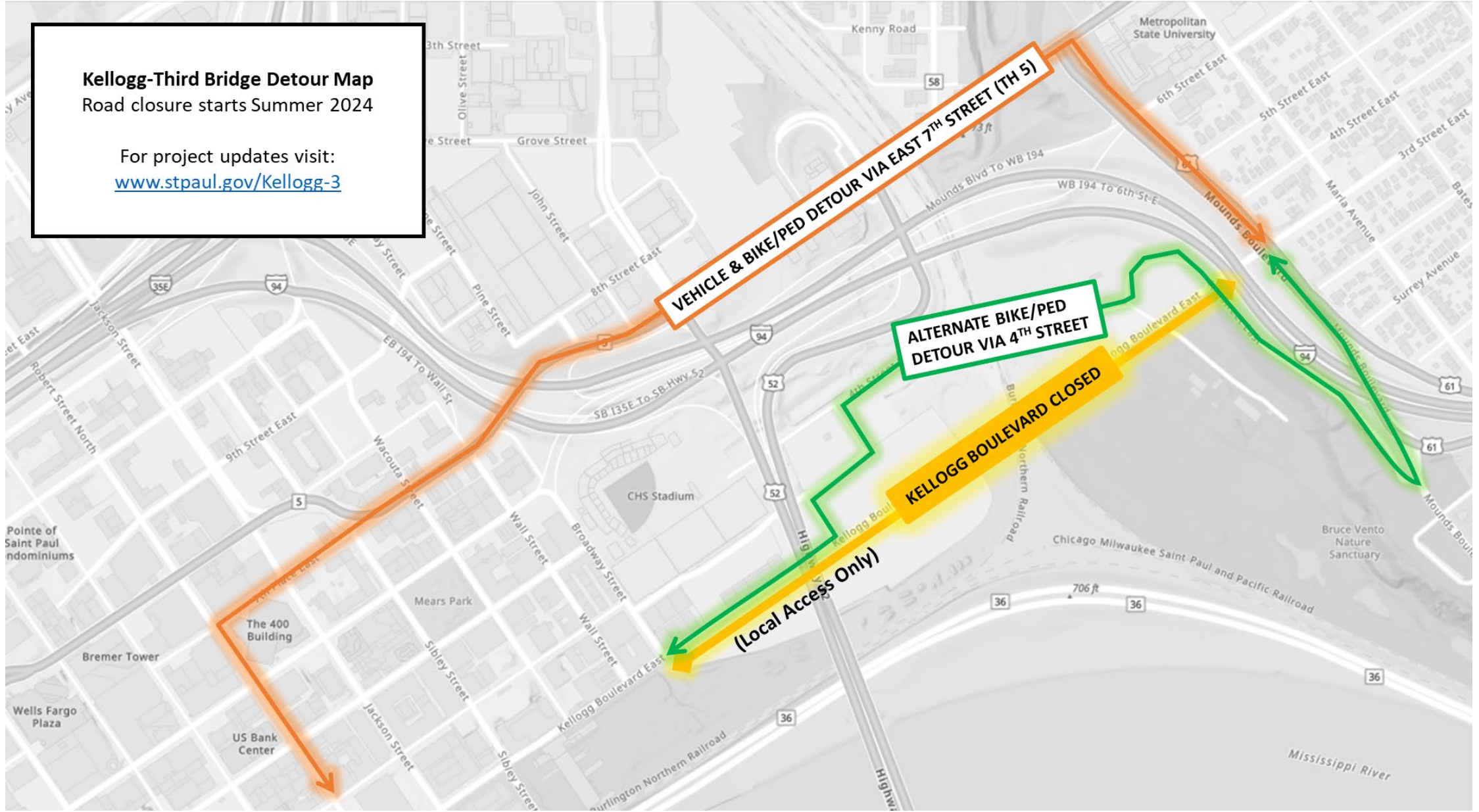

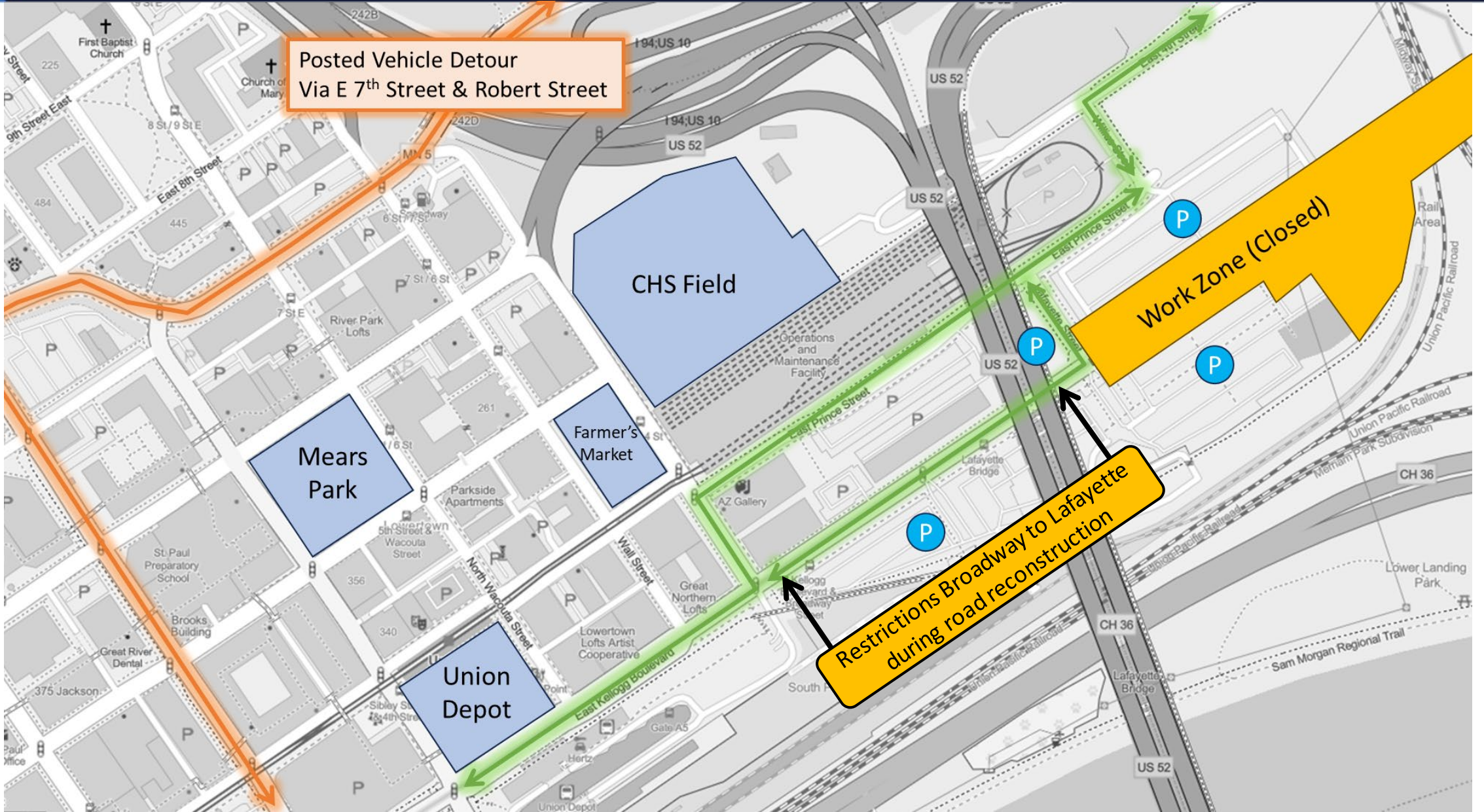
Kellogg-Third Bridge Detour Map
