What do you like about the Overlook? (Summary of comments received)

- Views Mississippi River Gorge, nature and wildlife, enjoyment of seasons
- Peaceful, quiet, not too busy, limited impact on surrounding natural environment
- Parking access to Hidden Falls and other park amenities including access to Highland Bridge community
- Location easy to get to by bike and by walking
- Good bird watching, especially during migration
- Resting spot for bikers, runners, and walkers

What could be improved about the Overlook? (Summary of comments received)

- Less parking, shift focus from cars to bikers, pedestrians, and neighbors who use the park
- Safety desire for security cameras, flashing crossing indicators to cross parkway, path and parking lot lighting, raised crossings for bikes/pedestrians
- Removal of invasive species
- Selective clearing to enhance views to River retain natural feel
- Water source for drinking fountain
- More benches/seating areas and bike parking
- Create more welcoming space improve pavement condition, upgrades where necessary; currently looks neglected
- Desire for connection from Overlook to lower Hidden Falls area

What do you think is missing at the Overlook? (Summary of comments received)

- Trees (desire for more trees), trees at center overlook area
- Connections to lower park areas
- Seating, small picnic shelter
- Better parking
- Connection to nature passing and parked cars detract from potential connection to nature; beautiful location wasted by large parking lot
- Access to water, restroom
- Bike parking
- Better lighting
- Signage to trailhead and falls; maps; educational and interpretive signage describing natural and indigenous significance of the area
- Better views to River
