Outreach and events will be held throughout the project through April 2025.

What We Heard:

The community has spoken about Jackson Street during recent, nearby projects. The following is a summary of what we have heard:

- What the street looks like is important to the neighborhood, and it needs improvement.
- Accessibility is an issue including cracks in the sidewalk and roadway.
- Safety improvements are needed including increased lighting and better sight lines.
- Signage needs to be improved.

What We Are Doing:

The project will reconstruct Jackson Street between University Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue. The following improvements will be included:

- A new bikeway along the west side of the roadway
- Removal of all on-street parking
- New pavement
- New lighting and traffic control
- New trees and additional greenspace in boulevards
- Utility improvements including new water and sewer lines
- Retaining wall improvements

A portion of this street reconstruction project will be paid for by a 1% local option sales tax, called Common Cent. This sales tax was approved by Saint Paul voters in November 2023. A portion of the project will also be funded through assessments to property owners adjacent to the project.
