Kellogg Boulevard Project Update

Week of October 28, 2024

What is happening?

Kellogg Boulevard, between Broadway Street and Lafayette Street, will be paved on the week of October 28, 2024, weather permitting. Access to parking lots will not change during the work. Please follow posted signs and the direction of crews around paving equipment.

Noise and vibration during paving is comparable to work that has already occurred. Vibration monitors are active and provide data to the contractor, who will act to keep vibration below levels that would be of concern to building foundations and walls.



When will the road re-open to traffic?

We expect Kellogg Boulevard (between Broadway Street and Lafayette Street) will re-open to regular traffic by November 15. For safety reasons, the following work activities must be completed after paving and before opening the road:

- Installing lighting and adjusting traffic signals
- Adding asphalt “wedges” around curbs and utility manholes
- Placing soil behind curbs and protecting it from erosion
- Installing road signs and pavement markings

Why will the road appear unfinished?

The final layer of asphalt will not be added until after new bridge supports are constructed, most likely in 2026. The asphalt wedges around curbs will help to reduce bumps during this interim phase.

Towards the end of the project, the top layer of pavement near Broadway will be ground off. A final layer of asphalt will be laid to create a continuous roadway between Broadway Street and the Bridge, to provide a smooth driving surface.
