

- » Improve park & field space to support current & future activities.
- » Improve tree canopy & provide shade where possible.
- » Create entrance into the park.
- » Improve existing circulation.

- » New multi-use synthetic turf field
- » Accessible parking approximately (10-13 stalls)
- » Stormwater & site drainage improvements
- » Tree plantings
- » Restroom / storage facility


### Reasoning




2010 Systems plan noted Baker Park as needing improvements to the multi-use field.

Need for community programming as fields at El Rio are at capacity. West Side Boosters and Humbolt use fields from 3:45 pm to 9:00 pm April thru November. City of Saint Paul dropped youth sports fees and registration has increased 93% citywide. From a 2022 System Plan Community Interest Survey: Need to updating sports equipment and facilities In November 2023, the city passed Local Area Sales Tax to improve parks and streets in Saint Paul.






How far do you live from the park?


#### Rank what amenities are needed most?




#### What do you play at the ball fields?

#### What times of the year do you visit the park?




