



Dear Rondo-Frogtown Neighborhood Parents and Guardians,

The Rondo-Frogtown Loop is a new grant-funded initiative focused on increasing access to quality afterschool and summer learning opportunities for young people in the Rondo and Frogtown neighborhoods. This is a partnership between Saint Paul Public Library and Saint Paul Parks and Recreation. A 15-passenger Loop Van will provide transportation to registered young people (ages 10-18) between 6 programming sites and 1 housing site.

Programming Sites:

- Rondo Community Library
- Frogtown Community Center
- Jimmy Lee Rec Center
- Martin Luther King (MLK) Rec Center
- West Minnehaha Rec Center
- Black Youth Healing Arts Center

Housing Sites:

- Skyline Tower

Young people ages 10-18 can ride the Loop van for free to attend afterschool programs from 3-8pm Monday – Thursday. Program Expectations Agreement

<p>To create a space that is inclusive and welcoming for all riders, please follow these guidelines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Respect staff, community members, and yourself. • Respect the van and other people's property. • Engage in and promote healthy habits. • Use positive language. • Make safe choices and have fun. <p>Parks and Recreation Staff reserve the right to remove participants for inappropriate behavior.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must have a destination when you get on the van. • You are responsible for getting to van pick-up and drop-off locations at the times listed on the van schedule. • Follow all instructions from the driver. • Respect other riders: keep hand and feet to yourself and do not distract the driver. • Keep the van clean – no writing or destroying seats, wall, etc. • Respect others' personal property. • Use an indoor voice (no yelling & shouting). • No loud music or noise from cell phone or bluetooth speakers. • Use appropriate language at all times (no curse words). • No cigarettes/vapes, drugs or alcohol. • No weapons allowed.

I understand that the van is not a substitute for program sign-up; nor can The Loop be responsible for verifying or ensuring a child's attendance at any of the van stop programs.

I understand that The Loop Van is only intended to assist youth from age 10 through 18 in traveling the community to established program and housing sites and will stop only at designated times and locations, with no exceptions being made.

I further understand that neither The Rondo-Frogtown Loop, its programming partners, or the City of Saint Paul is assuming responsibility for the welfare of my child at pick-up and drop-off locations nor providing escort services to and from programming. I hereby agree to waive and release the City of Saint Paul, its staff, volunteers, employees, representatives, program partners, and agents from all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my child's participation in riding The Loop Van. This waiver does not apply to injuries or damages that result from willful, wanton, or intentional misconduct by the City.

I hereby give consent to have pictures of my children whether film, digital, print or other, used for the purpose of promotional material, educational activities, or for any other lawful display for the benefit of The Rondo-Frogtown Loop, its programming partners, and the City of Saint Paul and such materials will be the property of the City of Saint Paul and the State of Minnesota without the need for further permission.
