

RESOLUTION # 18-17
Parkland Diversion At 420 Portland Avenue

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission (“Commission”) is an appointed body established to advise the Mayor and City Council on long-range and city-wide matters related to the Department of Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, Section 13.01.1 of the City Charter requires that the Commission review any diversion or disposal of park property and present a recommendation to the Saint Paul City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul (“City”) owns land adjacent to 420 Portland Avenue for use as a park and named Nathan Hale Park; and

WHEREAS, Arne Carlson and Julie Carlson, the owners of 420 Portland Avenue, are requesting that the City sell a 1,322 square foot portion of its parcel to them; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation has determined that diversion for this purpose will have an impact on the parkland by reducing the size of the park; and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul Parks and Recreation Commission recommends the request to dispose of the parkland adjacent to 420 Portland Avenue be denied.
