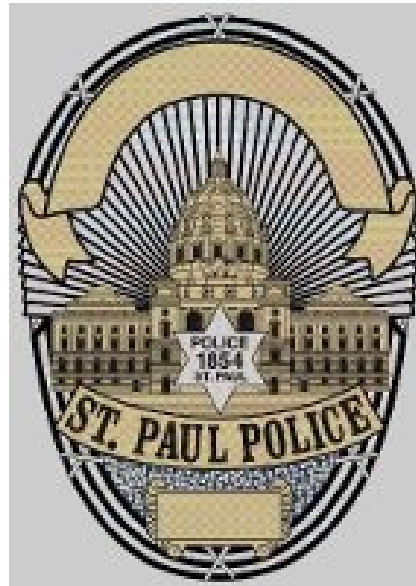

I would like to thank Mayor Carter and our City Council for their support, high expectations and willingness to assist us in delivering the trusted service with respect that you have come to expect from us every day.

I am proud of the many changes we have made this past year to better serve the needs of the people we serve and protect. Some of those changes include the department-wide implementation of body-worn cameras, the relocation of our Police-Civilian Internal Affairs Review Commission, the expansion of our Community Engagement Unit, the total review and revision of our response to resistance and aggression policies and training and the opening of our new Richard H. Rowan Public Safety Training Center.

This state-of-the art training facility would not have been possible without the generous support of Mr. John Nasseff who, sadly, passed away early this year. Mr. Nasseff cared deeply for our officers, staff and the people of the City of Saint Paul. He truly was a shining example of what we can achieve when we all work together for the good of our community.

In 2017, we saw an increase in critical incidents such as homicides and shots fired. Effective 06/15/2017, the Saint Paul Police Department is no longer submitting UCR crime data managed solely by MetroTransit.

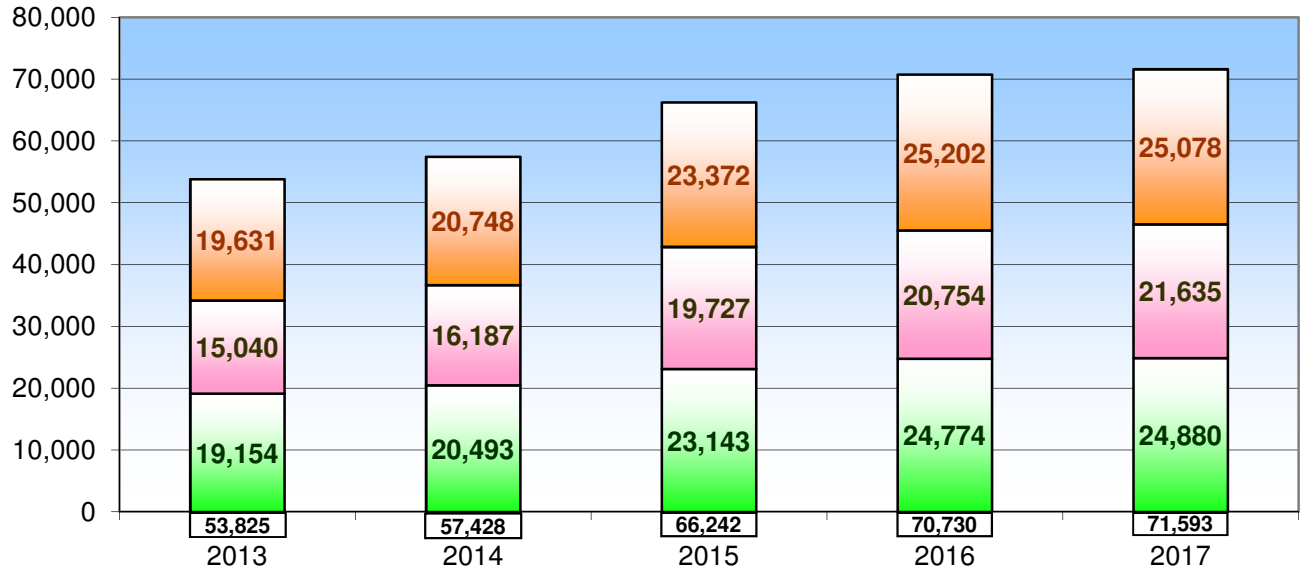

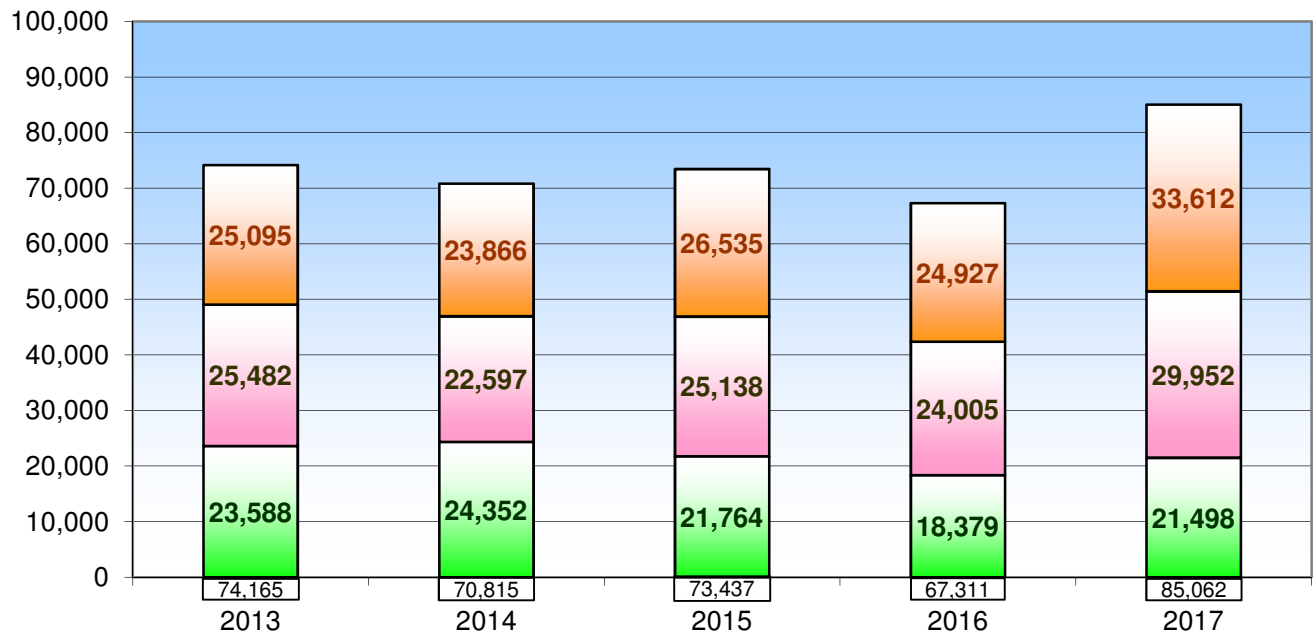
2013-2017 Incidents resulting from 911 by District

■ Eastern ■ Central ■ Western

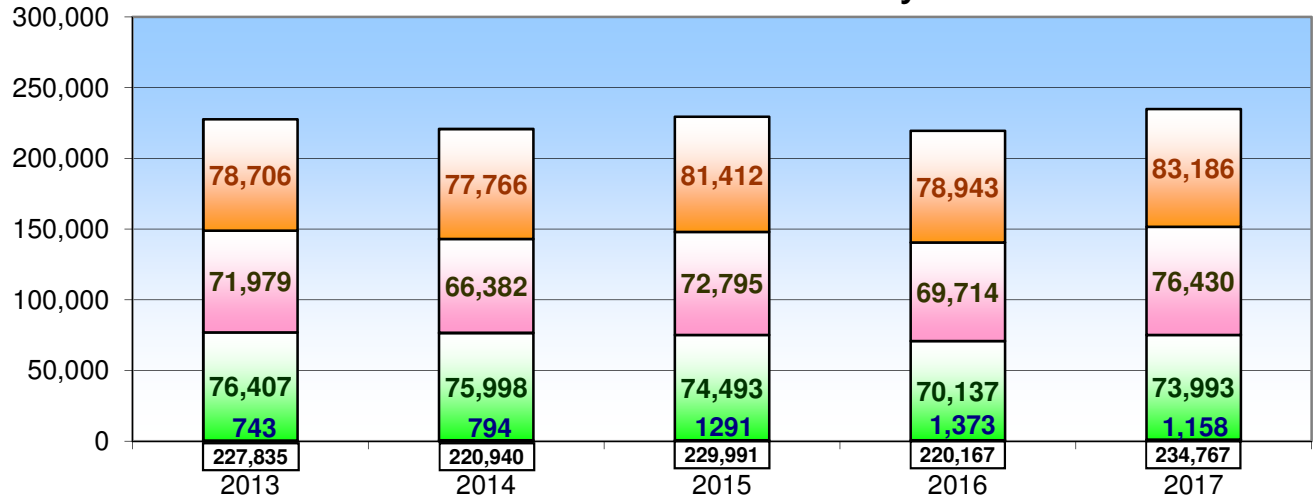
2013 - 2017 Proactive Police Activities by District

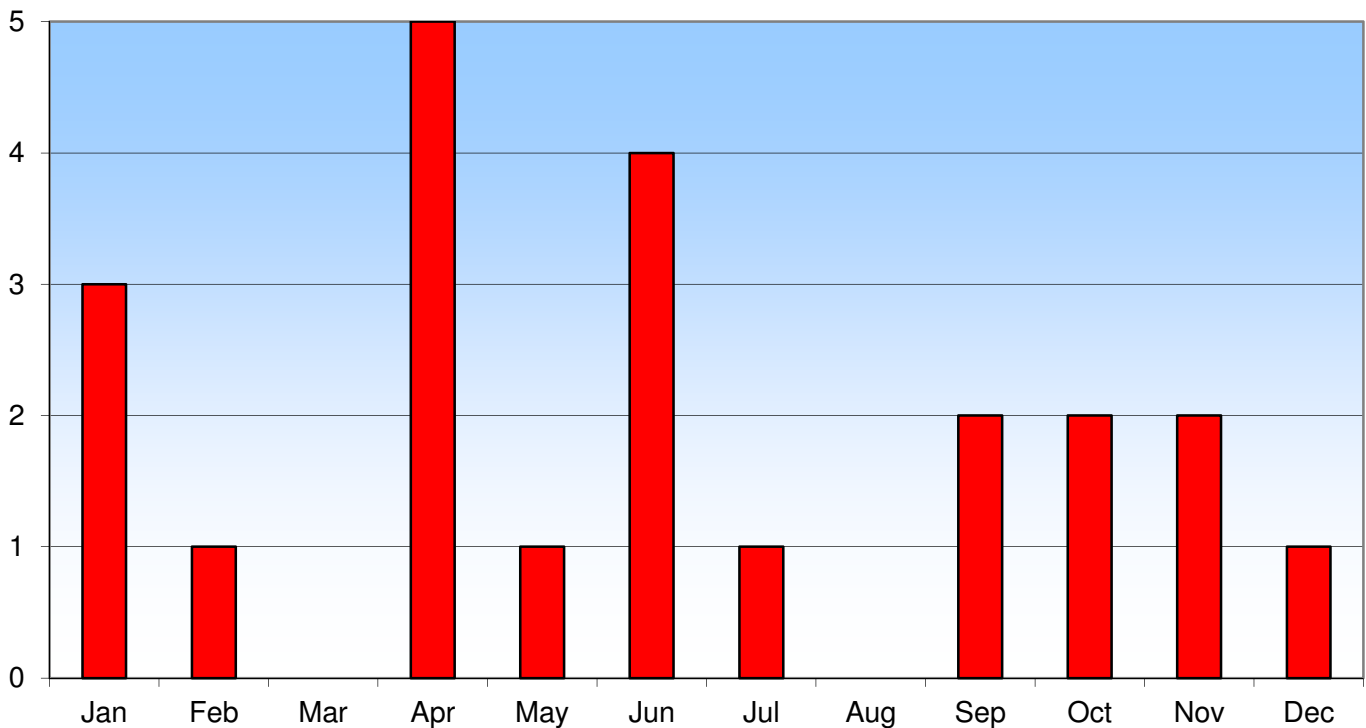

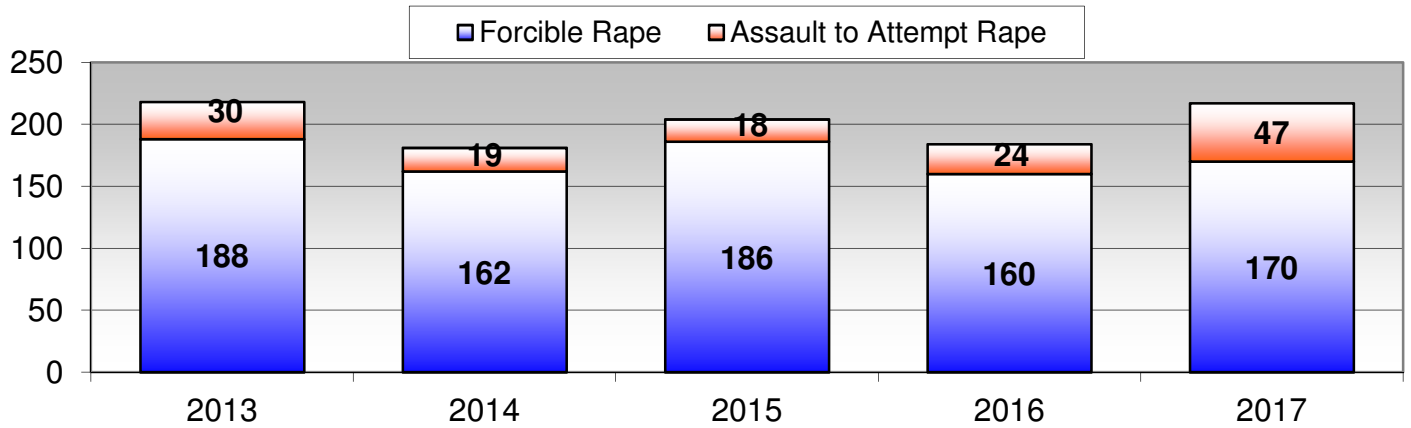

Definition: Penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person without consent of the victim.

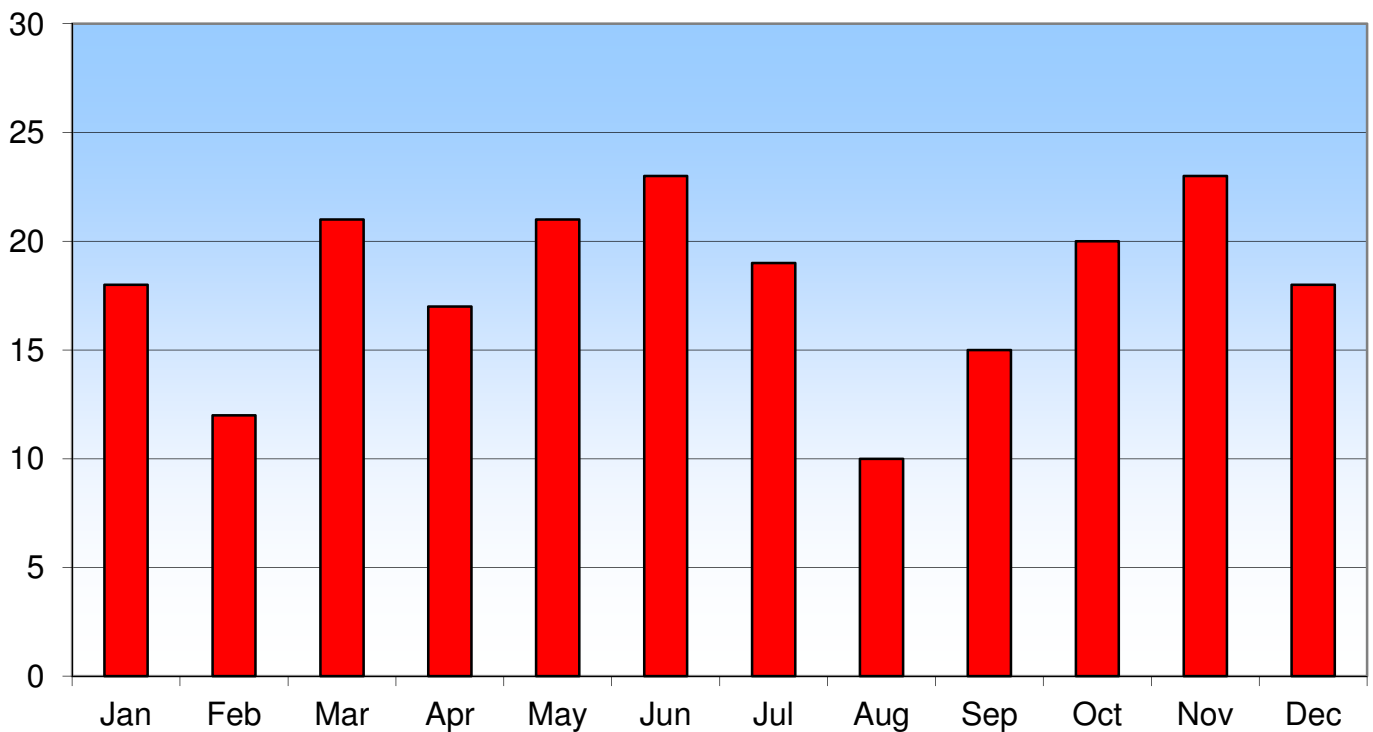

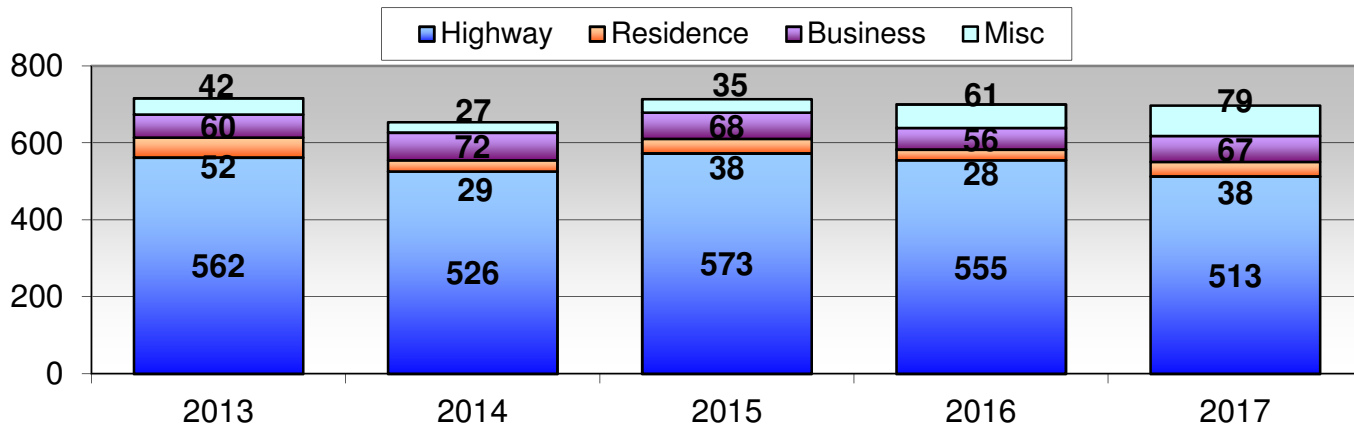

Definition: Taking or attempting to take anything of value from care, custody, or control of a person / persons by force or threat of force or violence and / or by putting the victim in fear.

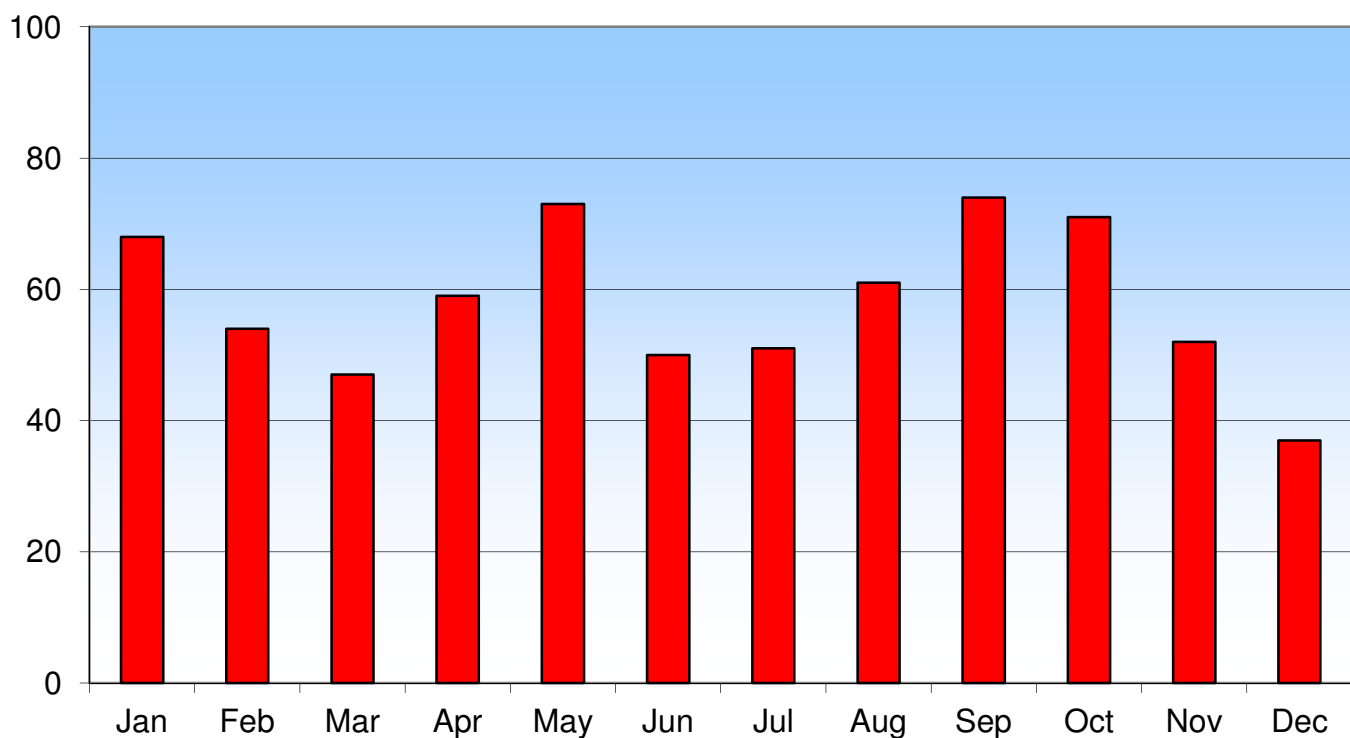

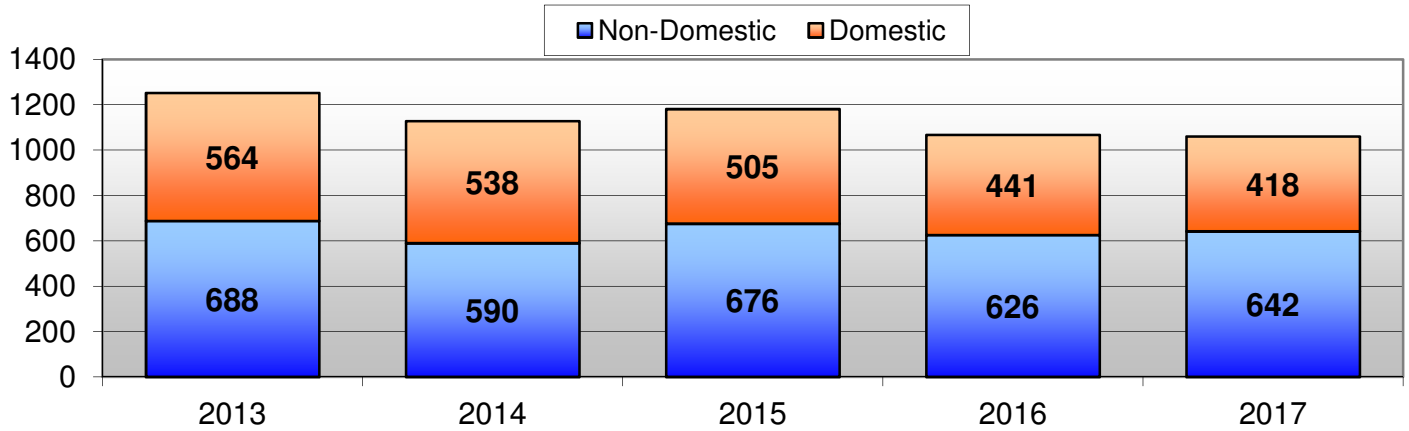

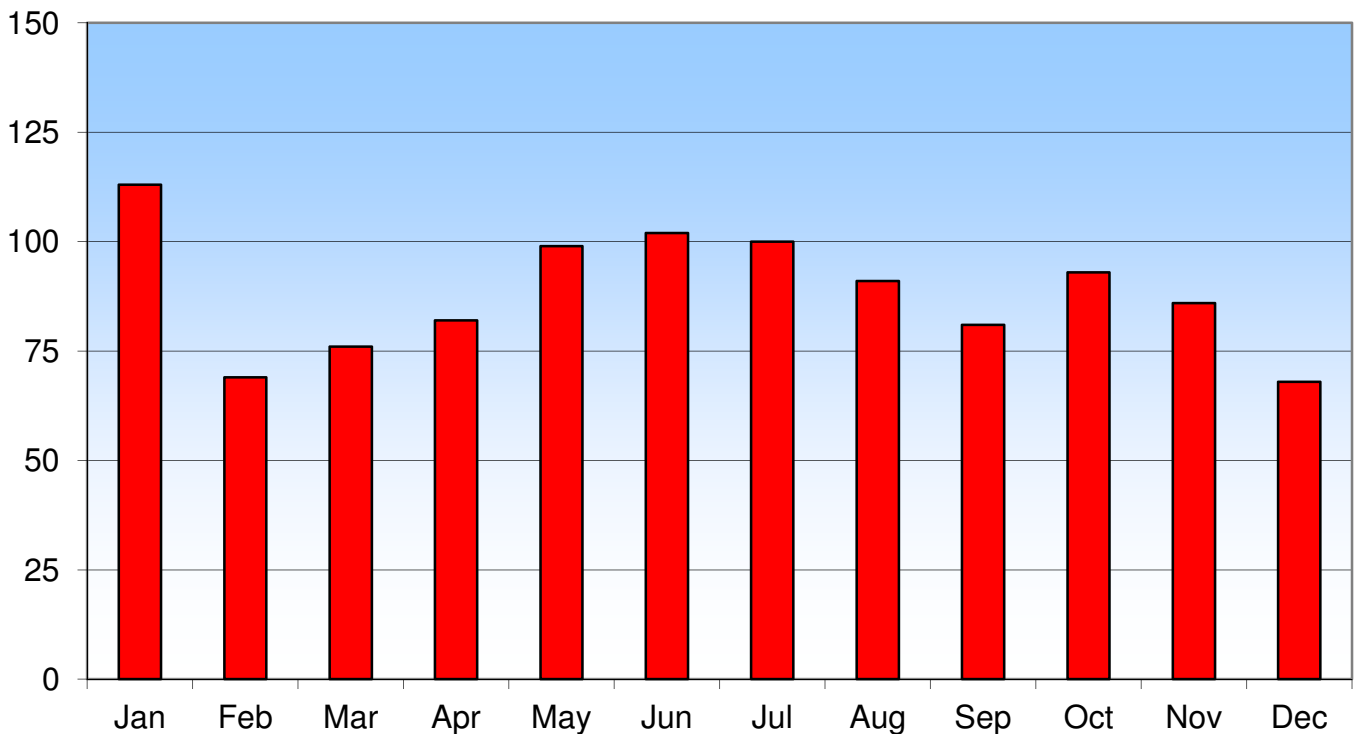
Aggravated Assault by Type

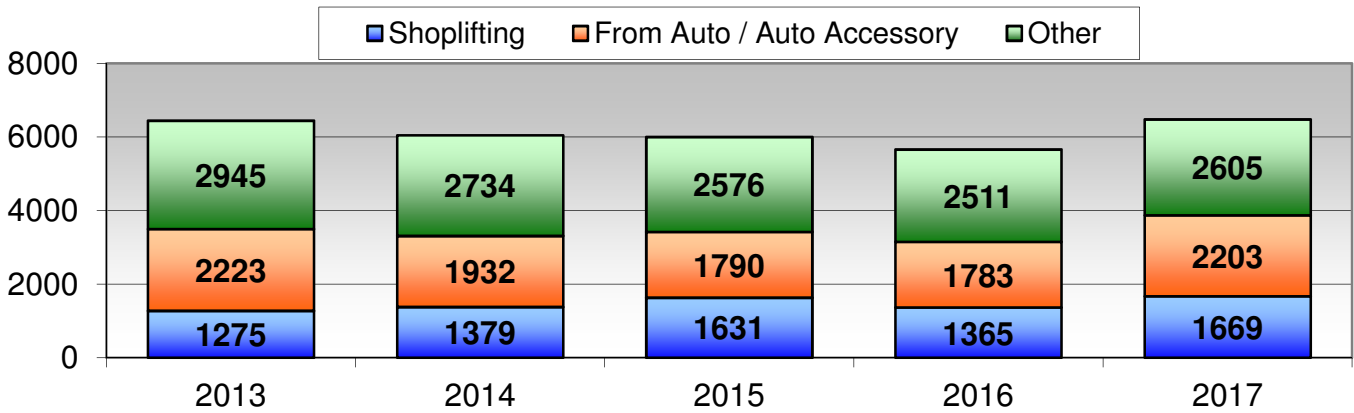

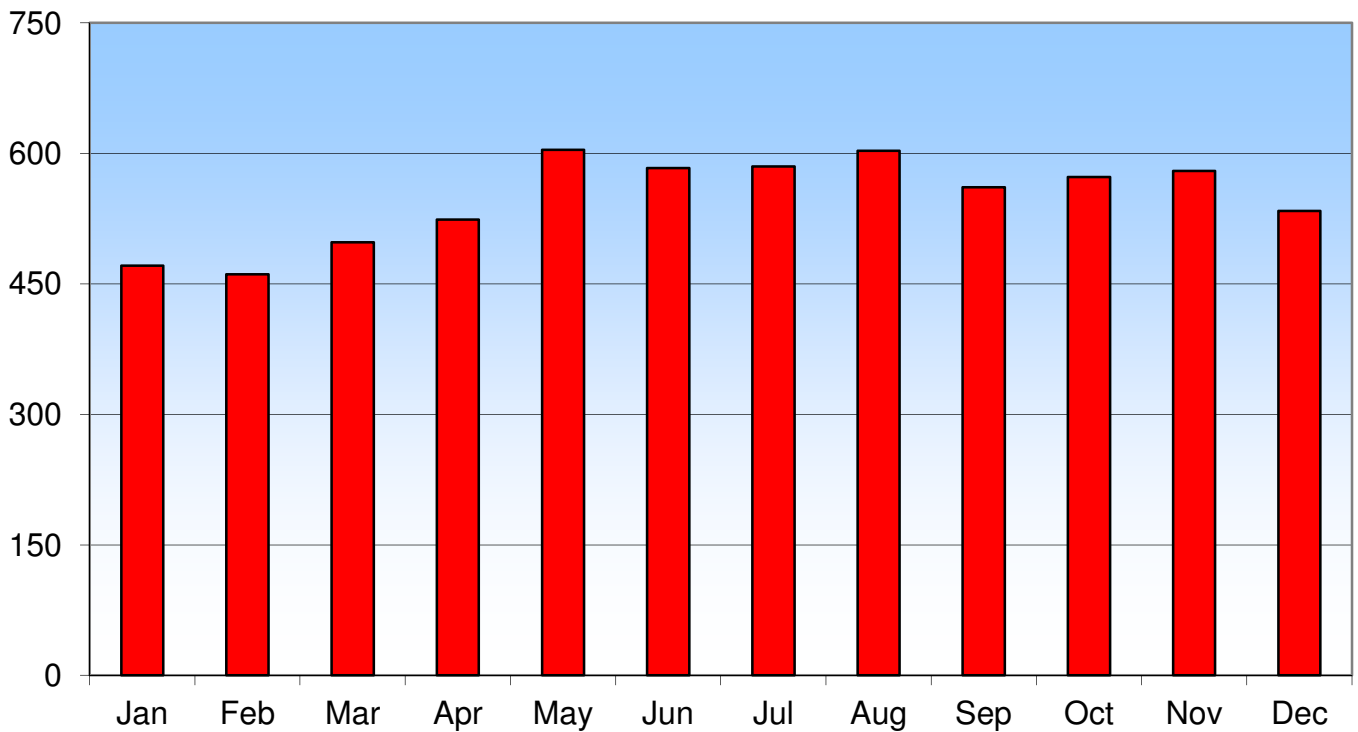

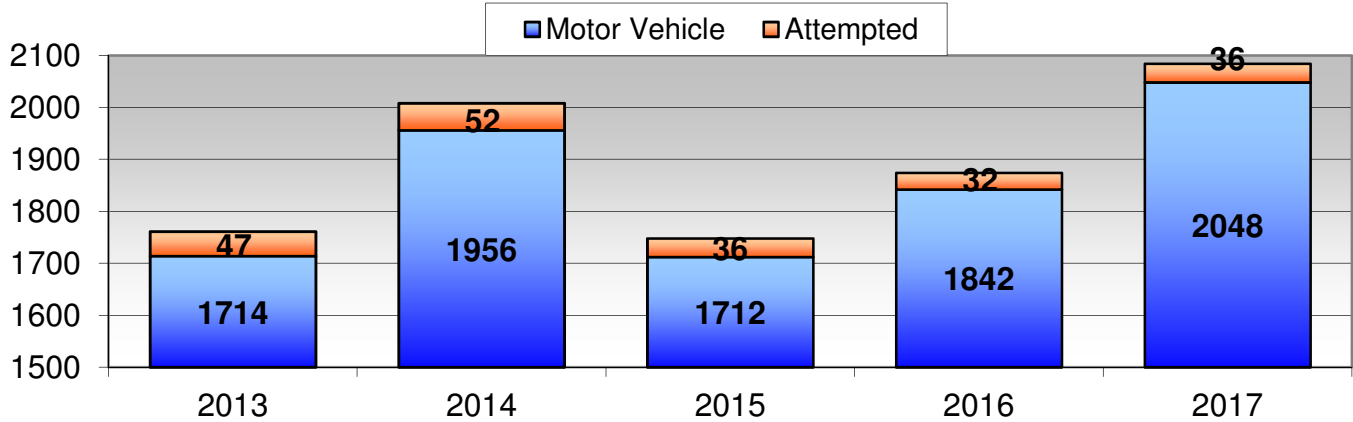

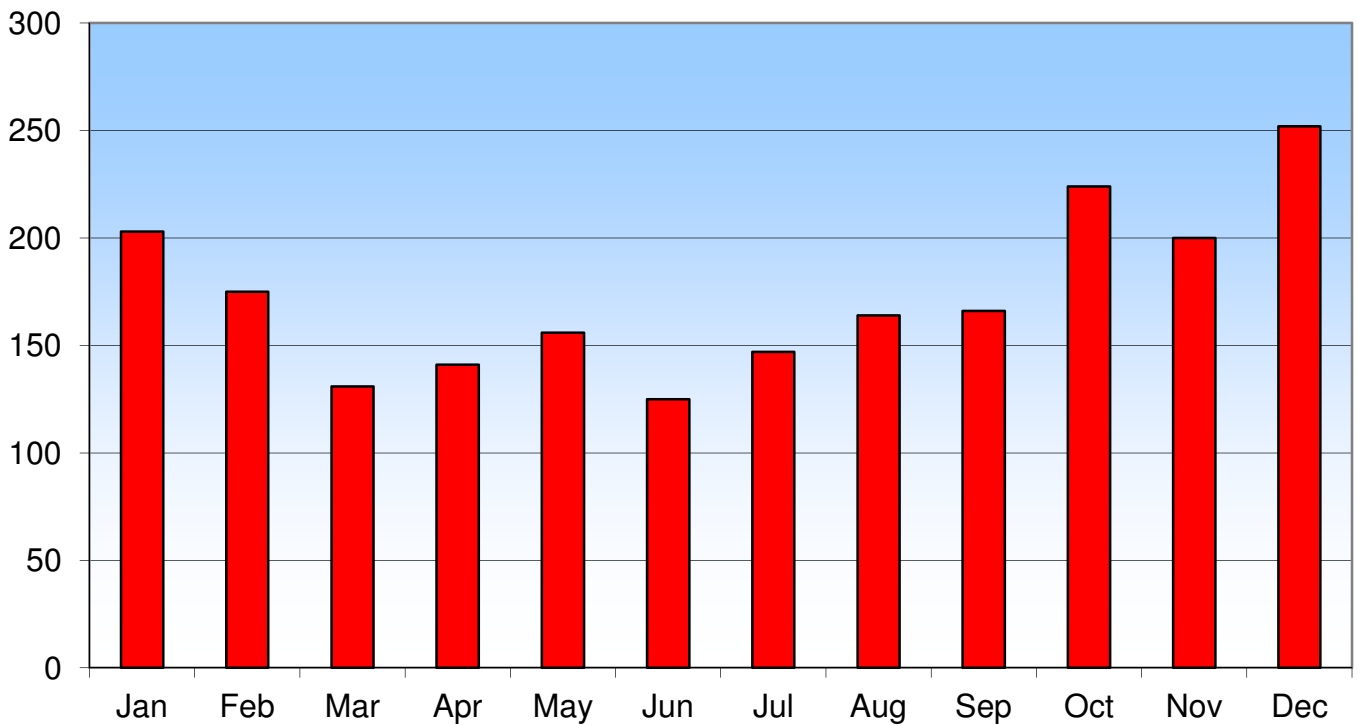
Motor Vehicle Theft by Type

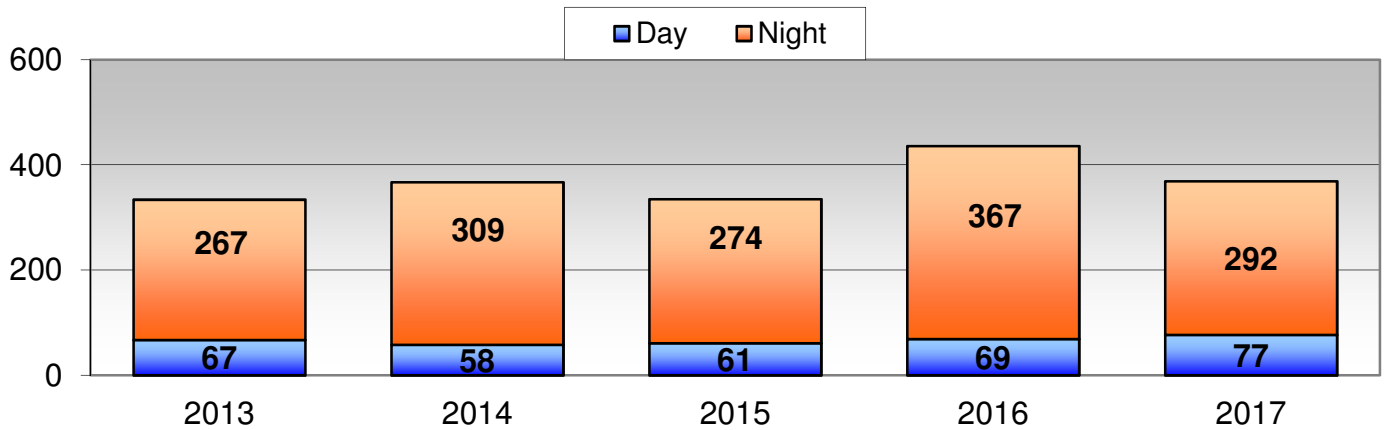

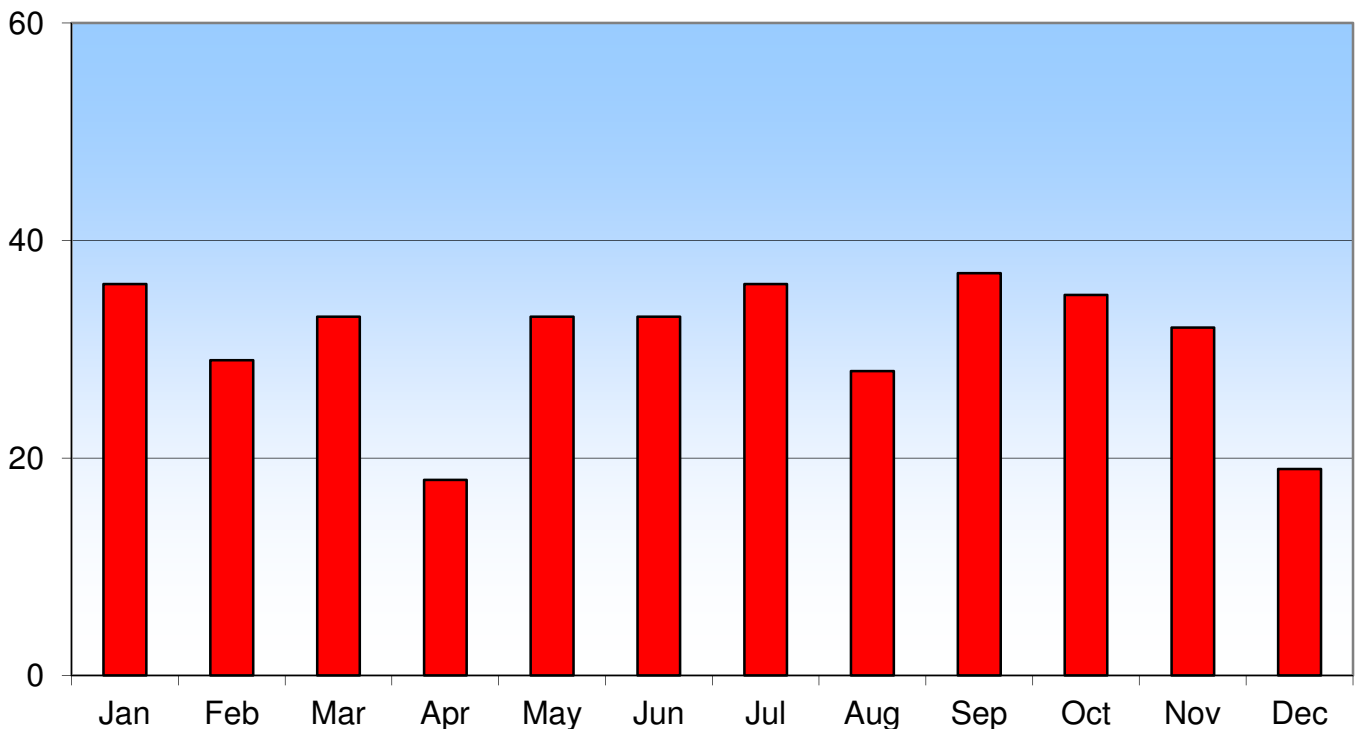

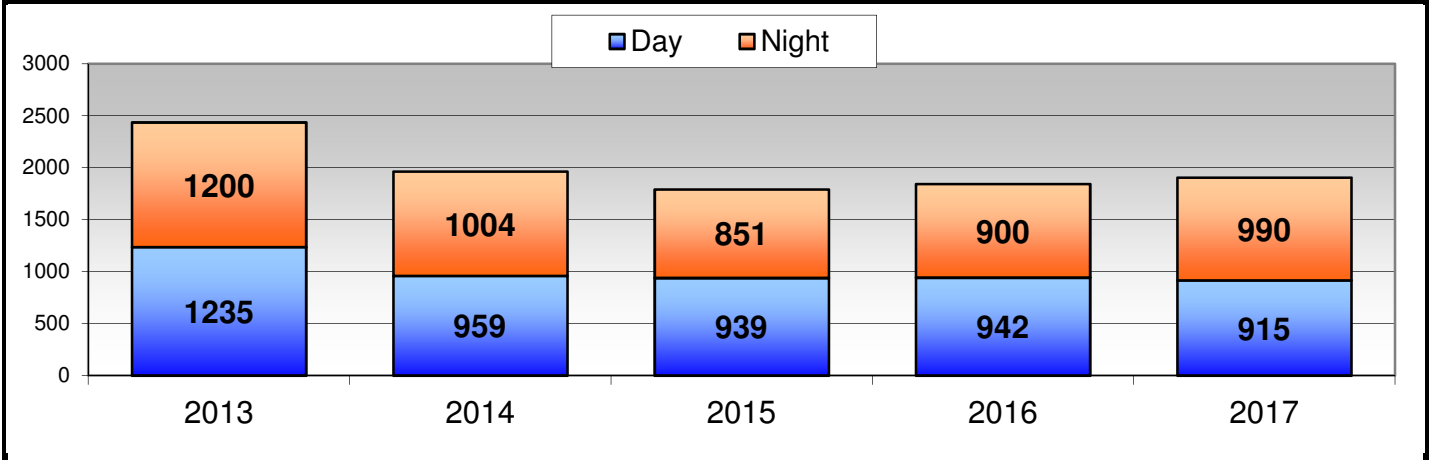

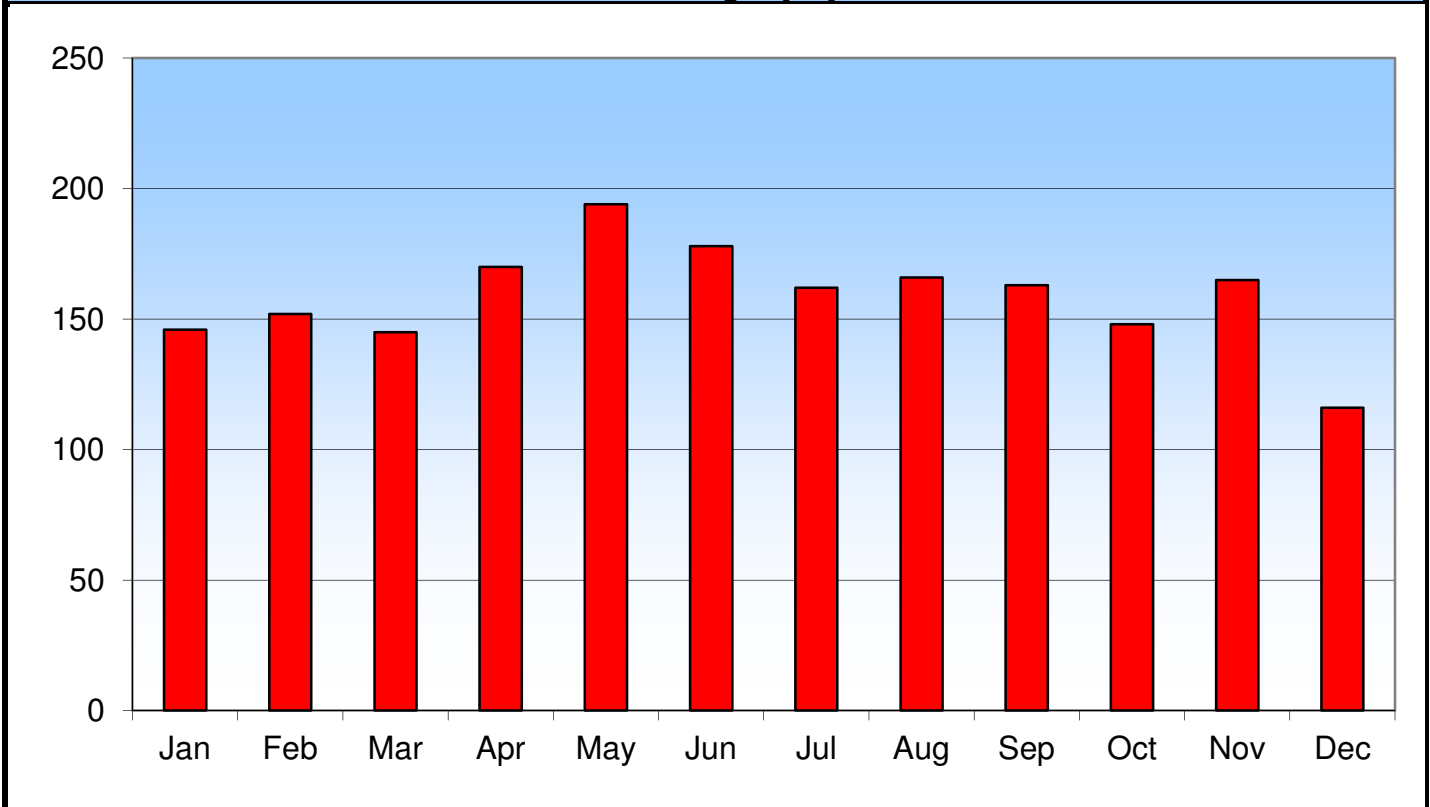
Residential Burglary by Type

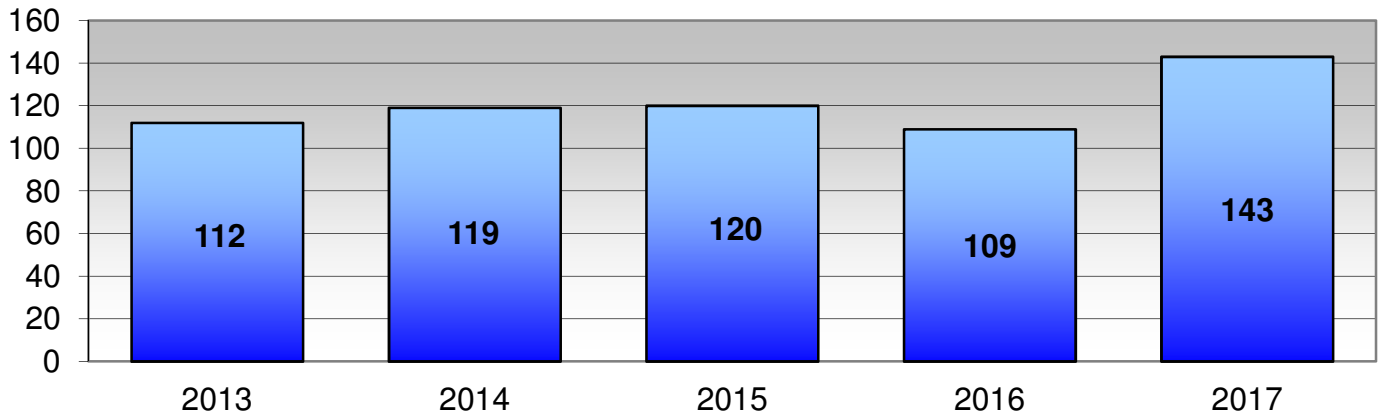

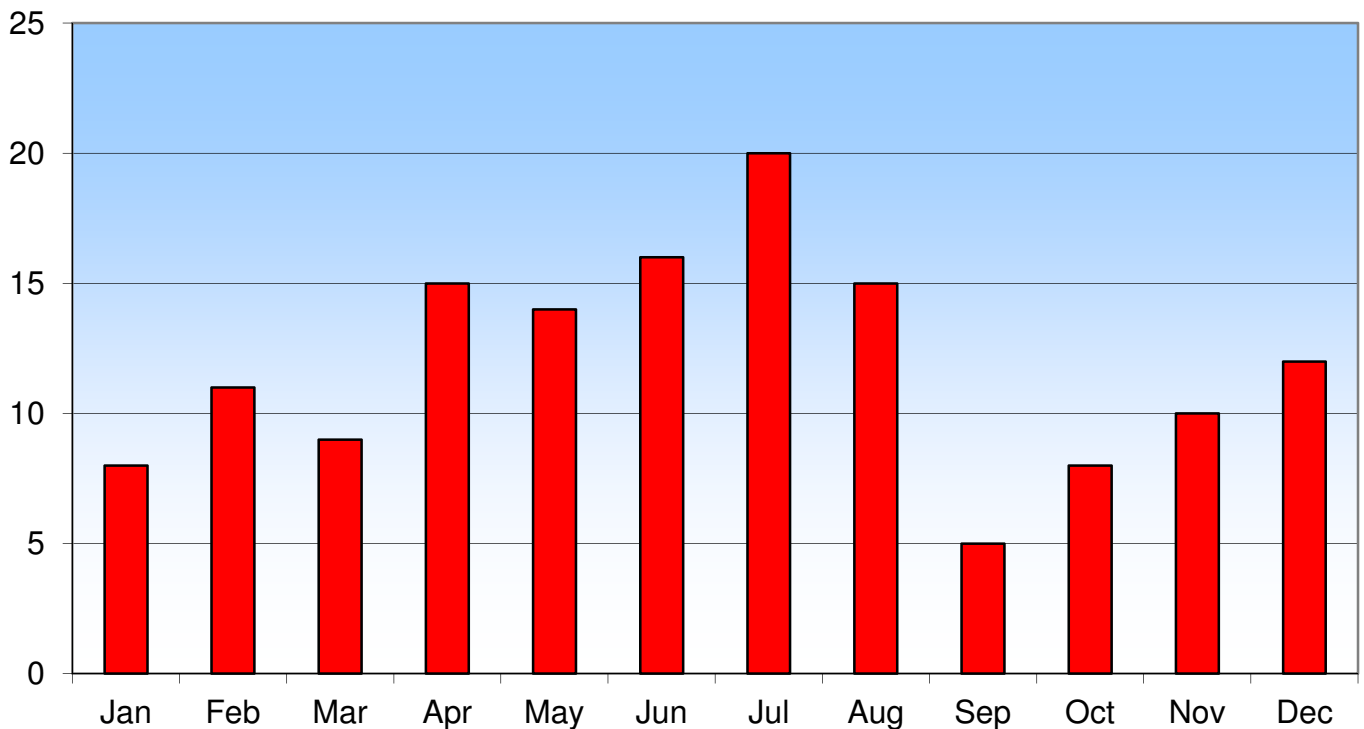

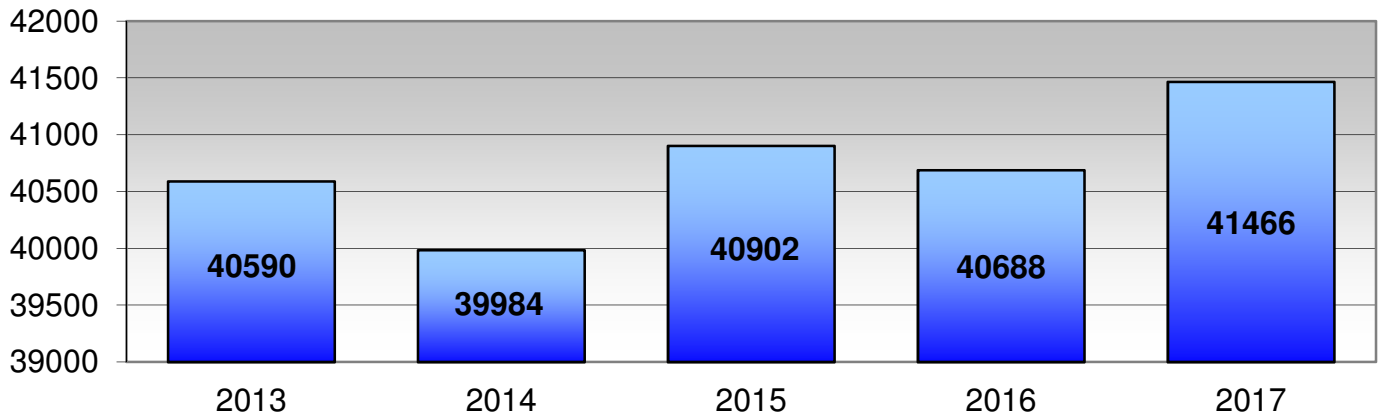

Definition: Commonly referred to as 'nuisance crimes'. These are violations that left unchecked, may negatively impact the quality of life of an area.

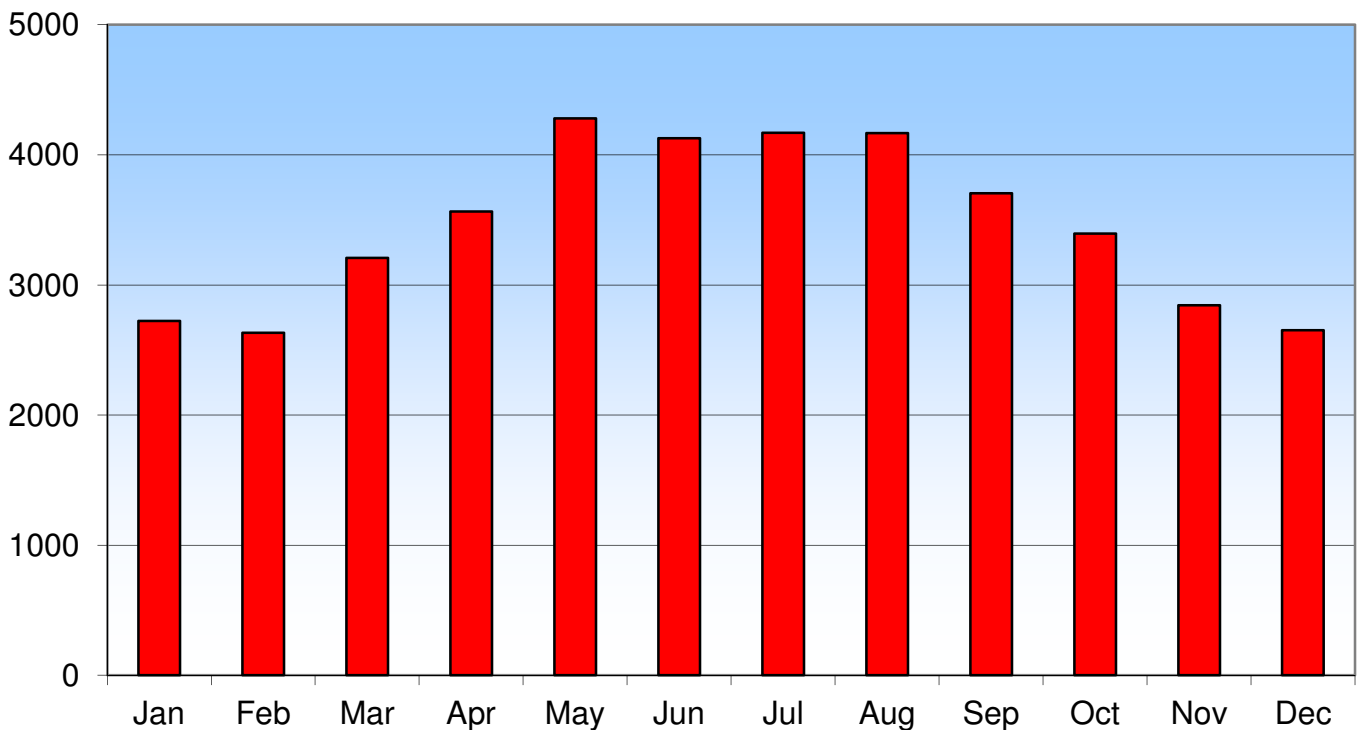
Quality of Life by Year

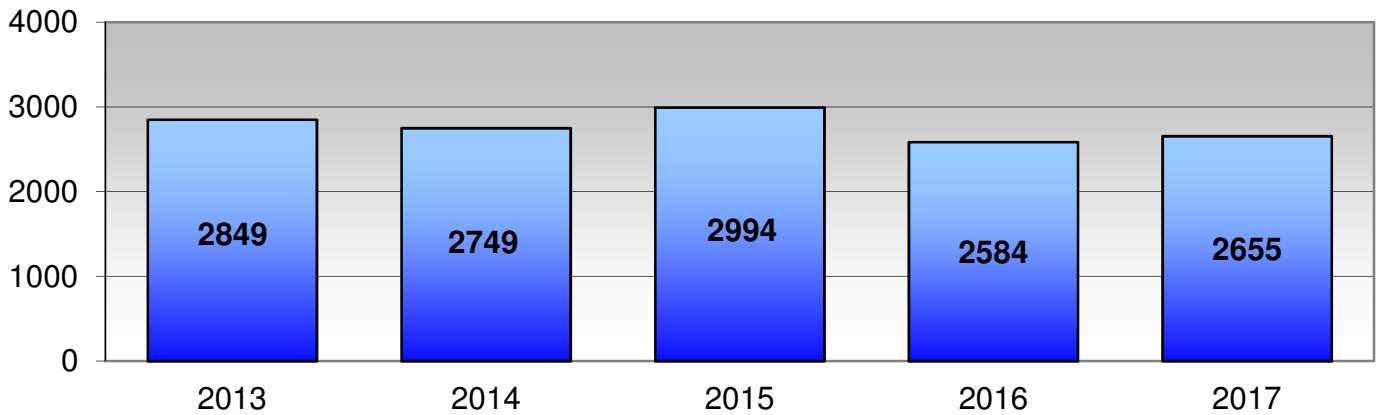

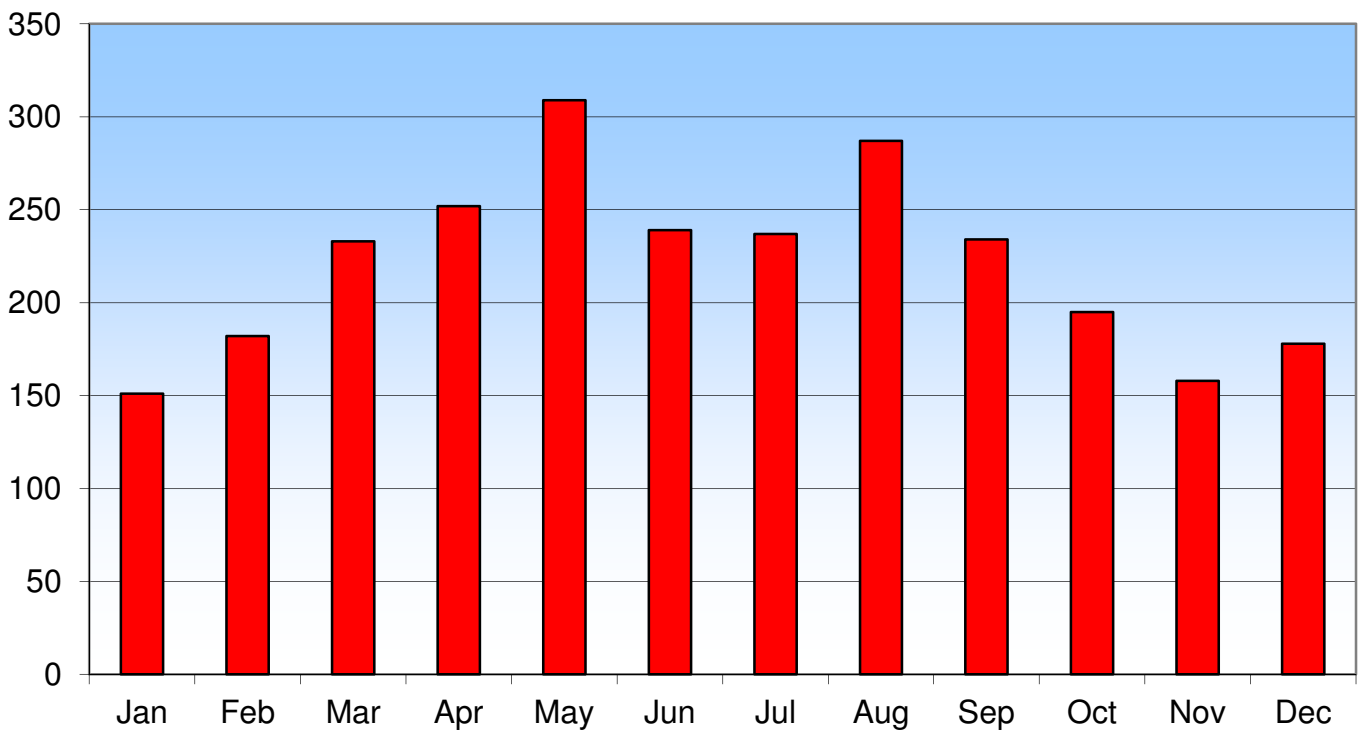
Narcotics by Year

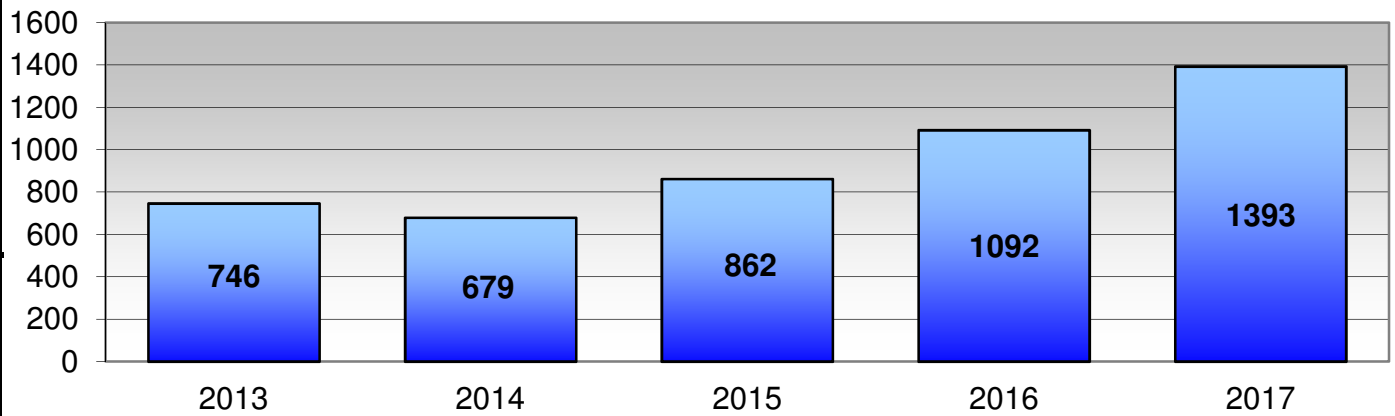

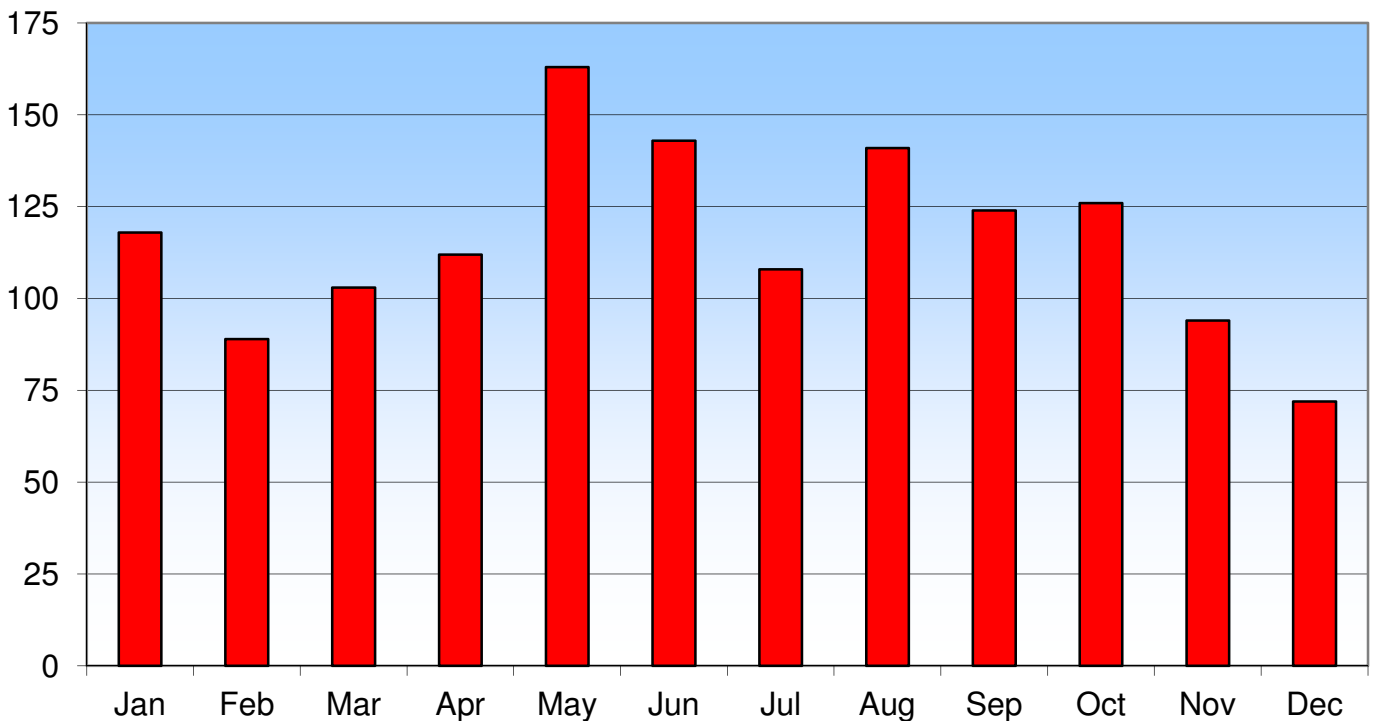
Weapon Discharge by Year

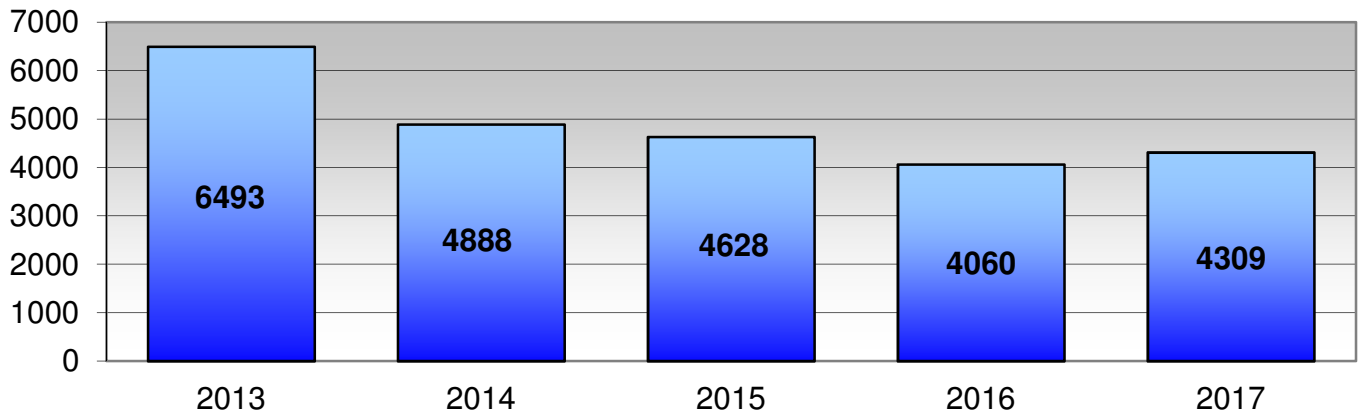

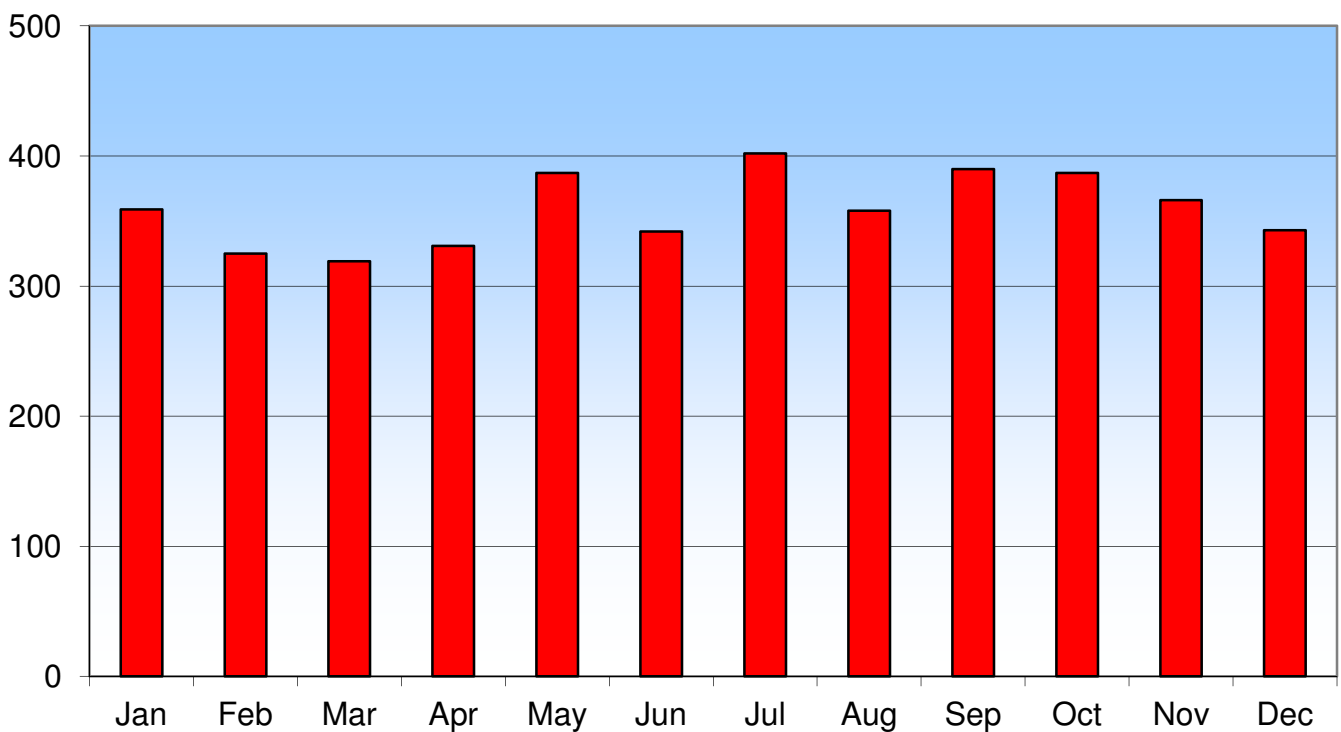

City of Saint Paul: Part 1 Crimes: 2017

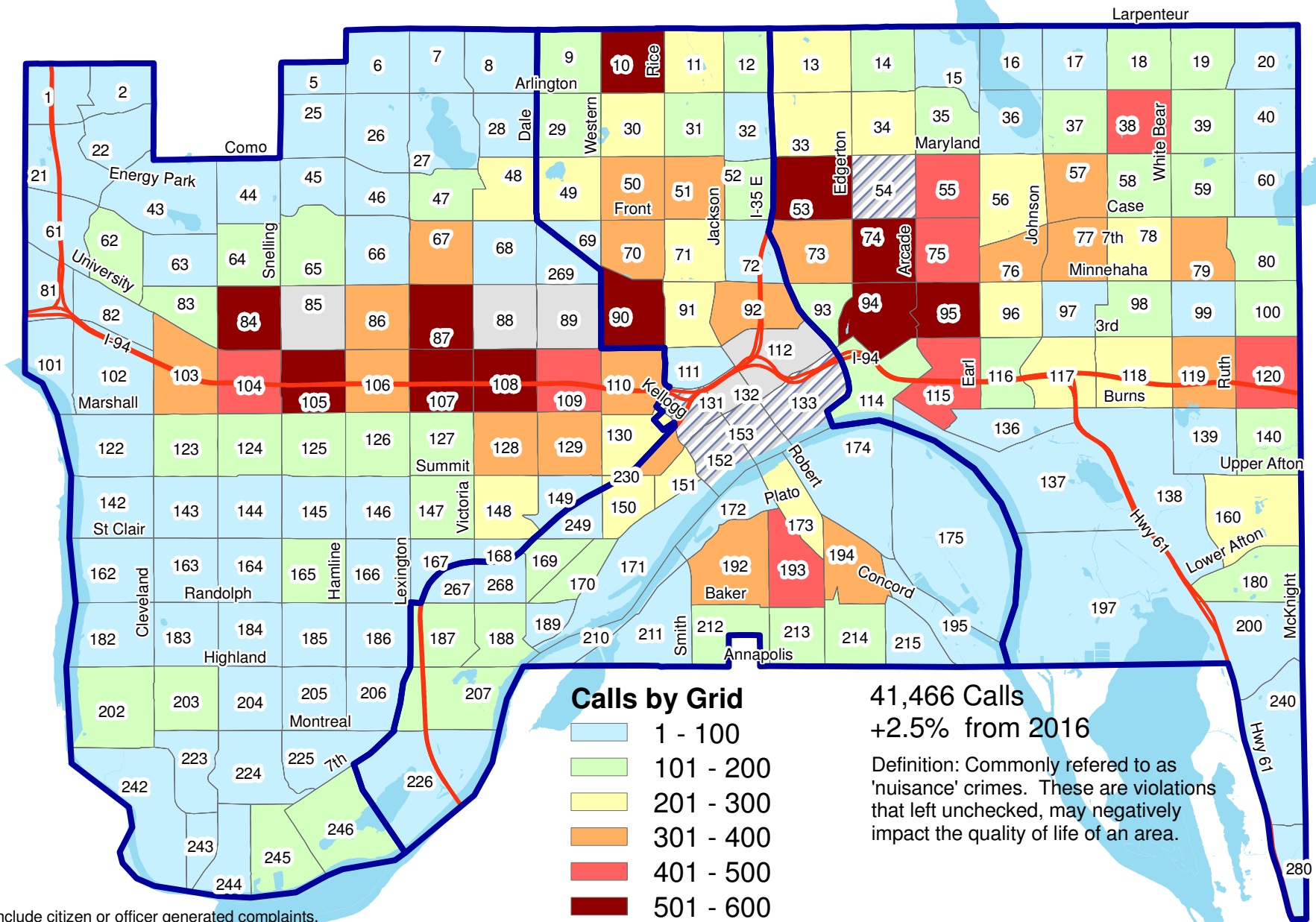

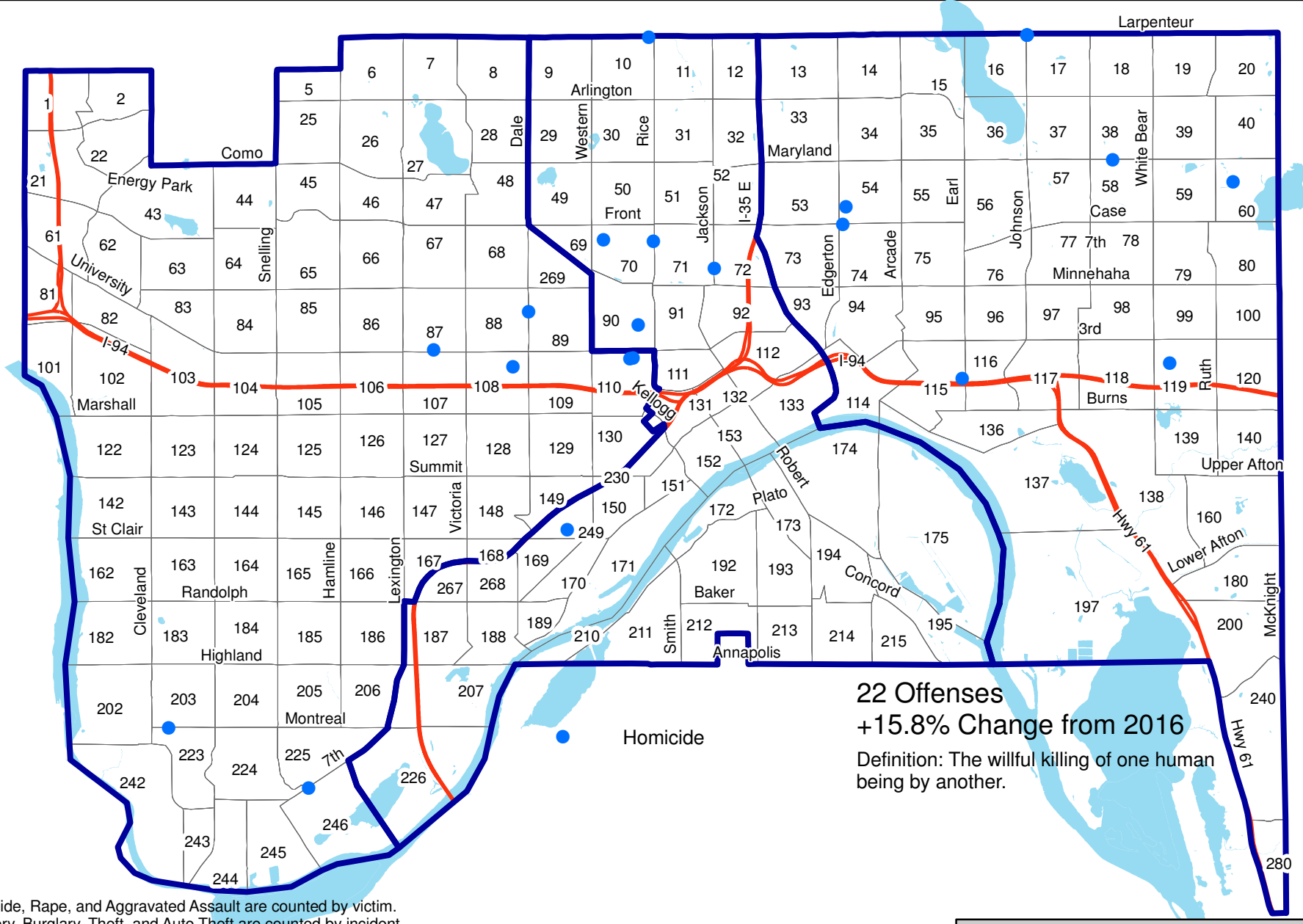

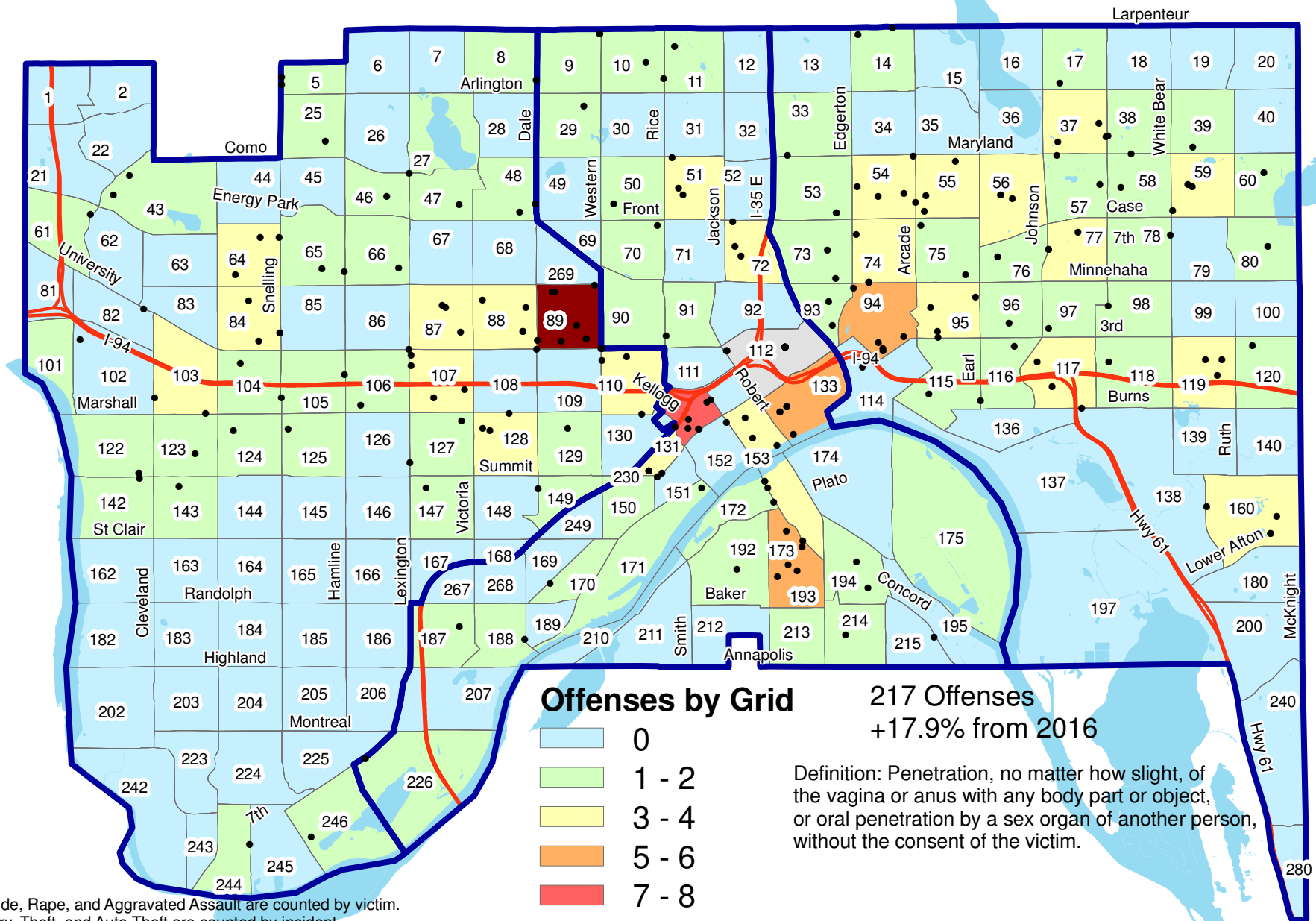

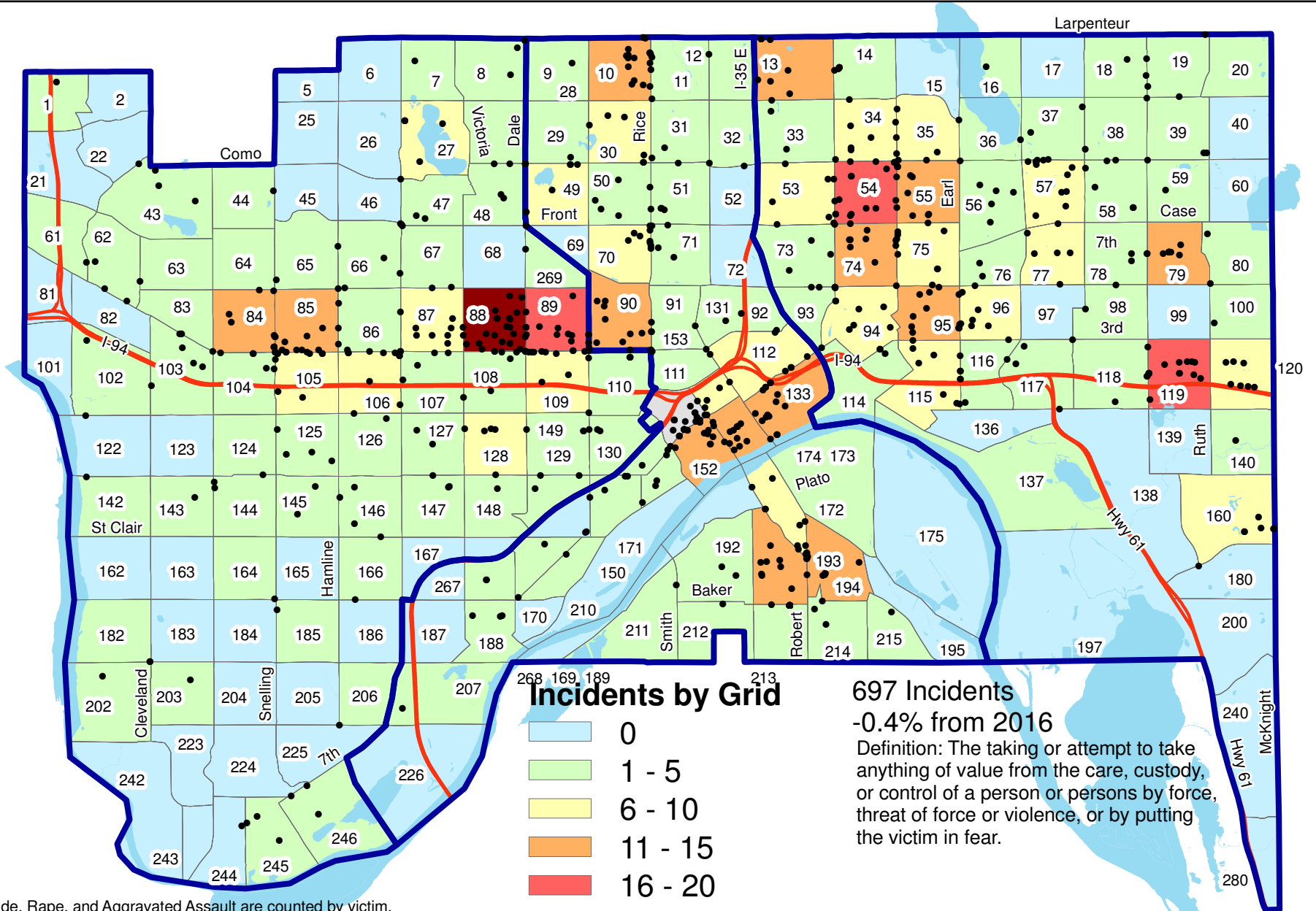

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City of Saint Paul: Robbery Incidents: 2017



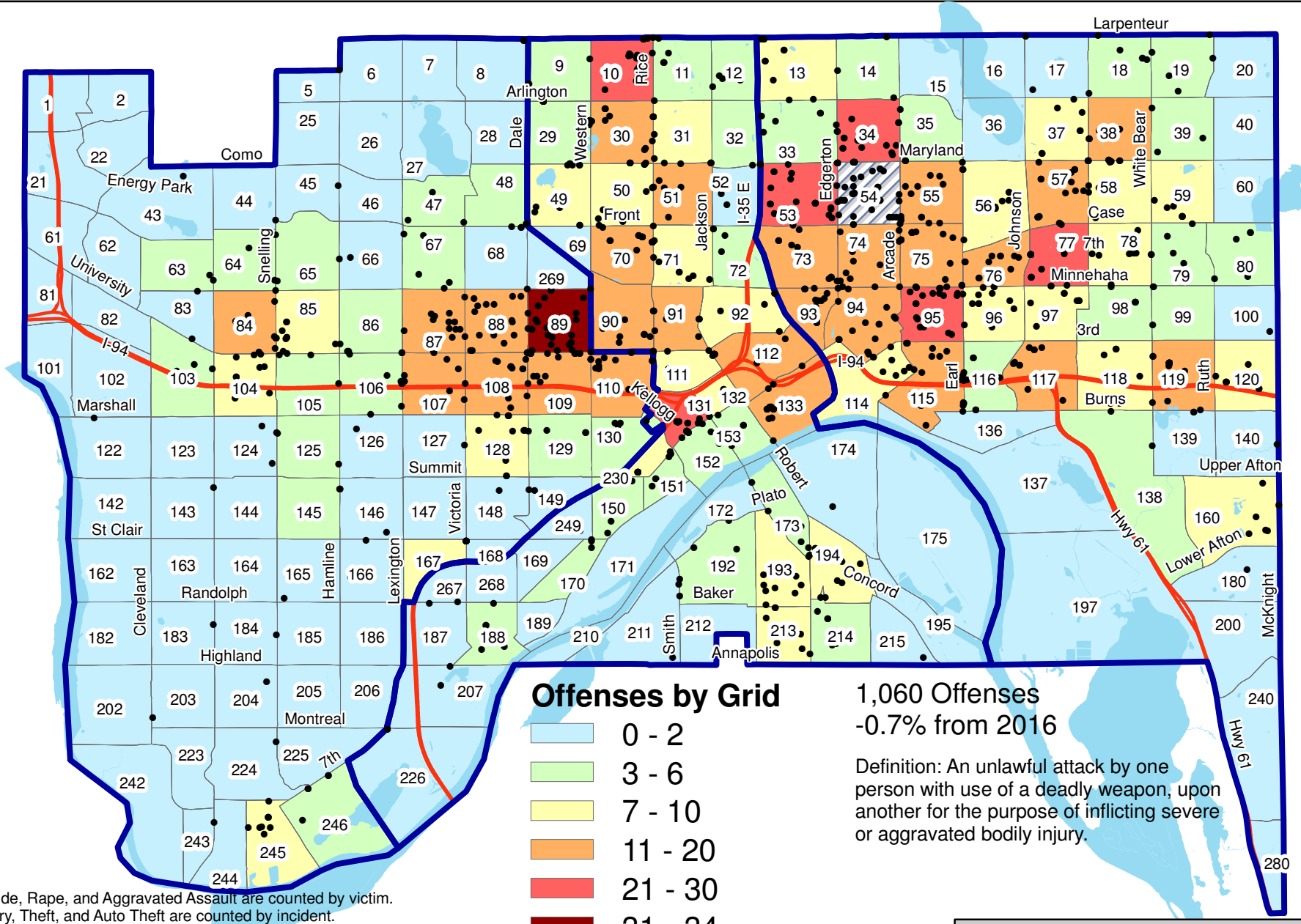

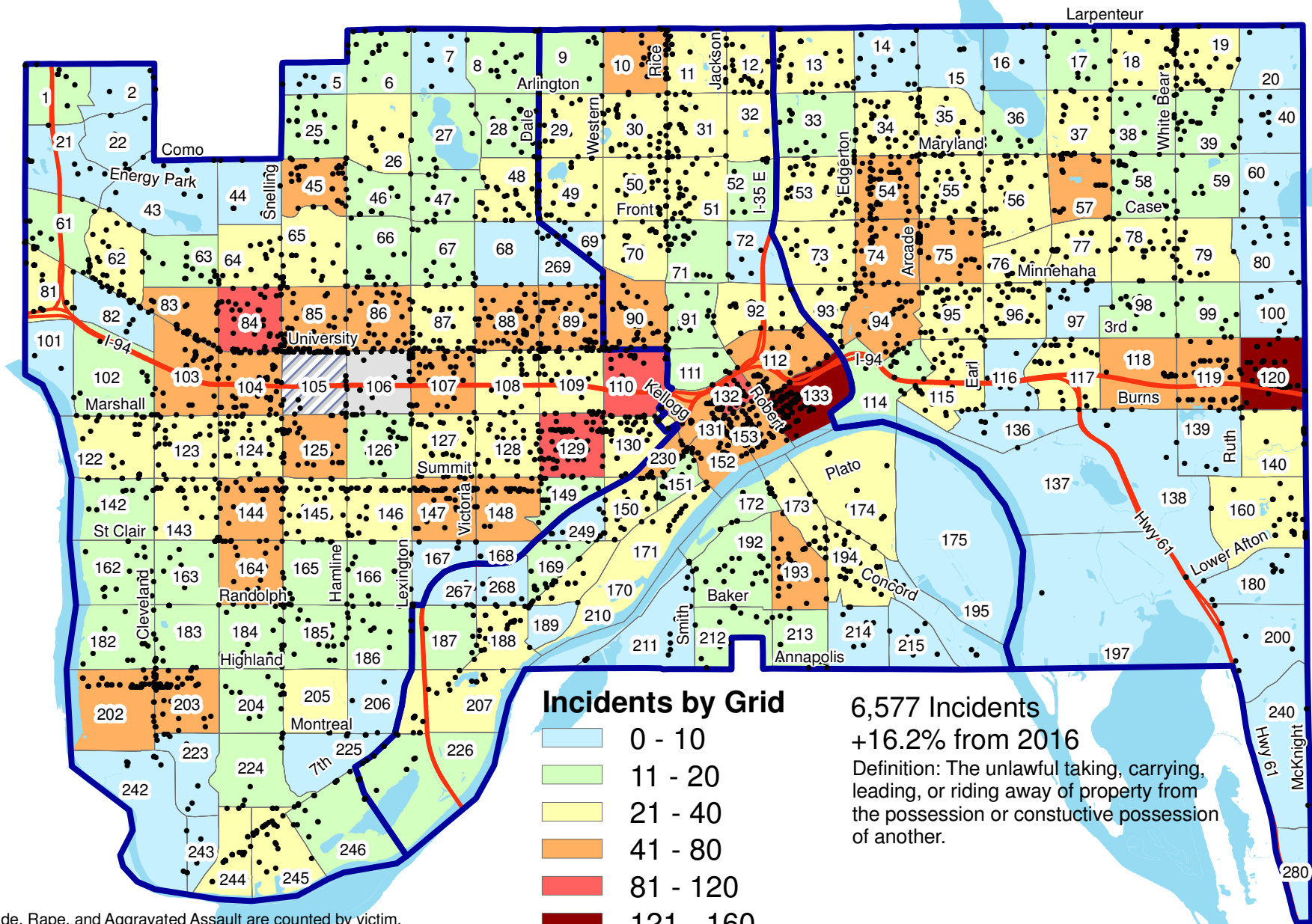

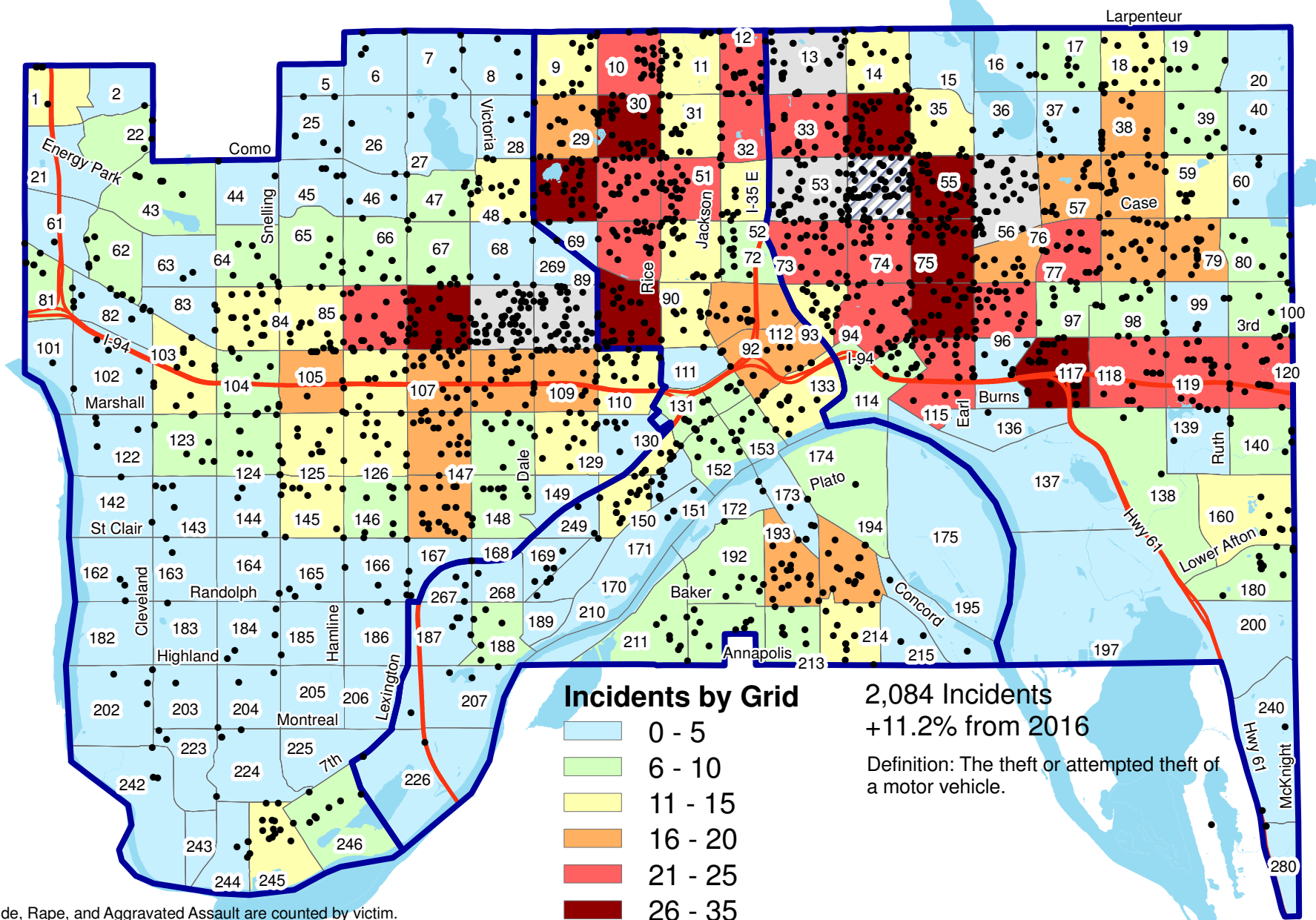

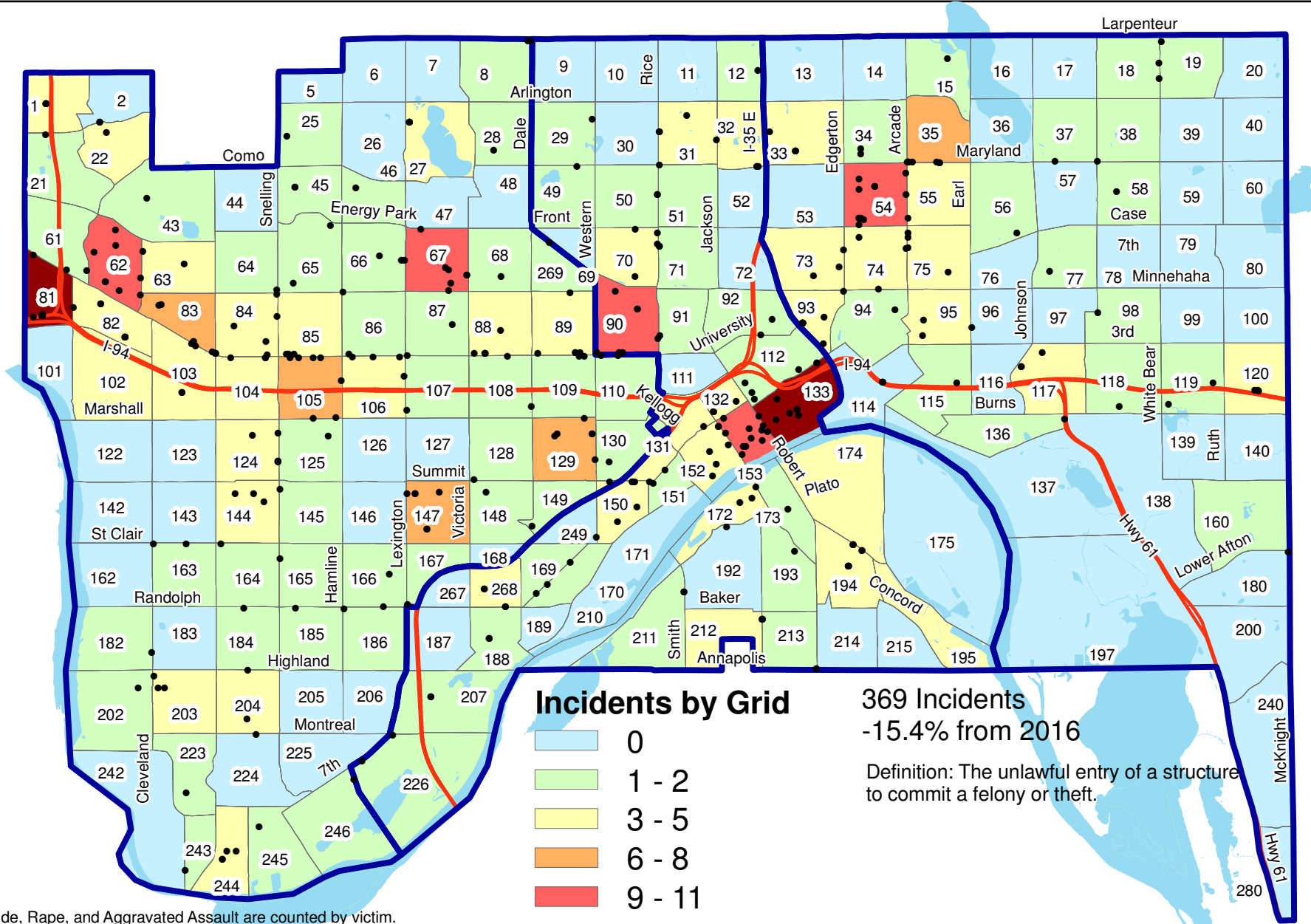

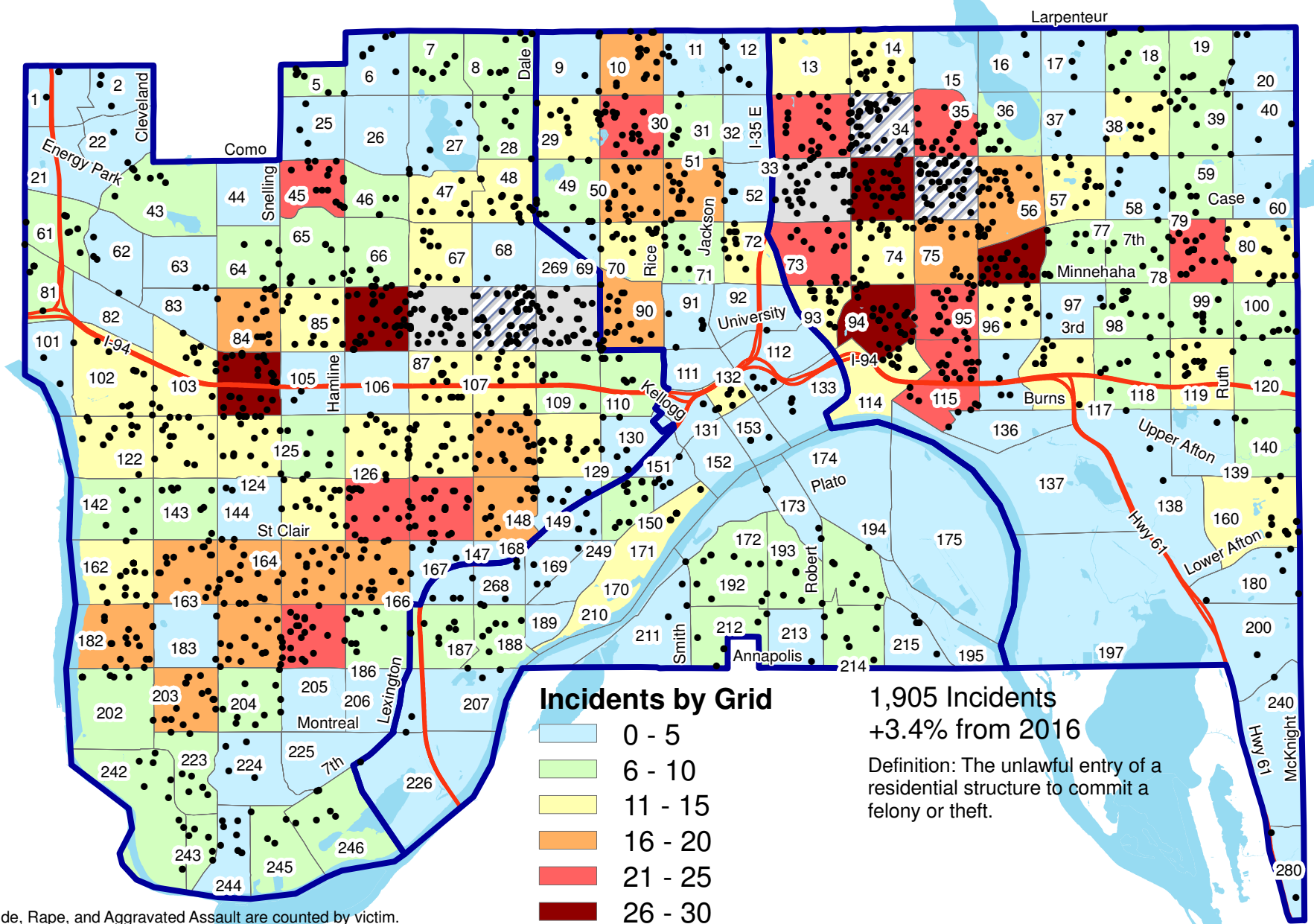

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City of Saint Paul: Residential Burglary Incidents: 2017



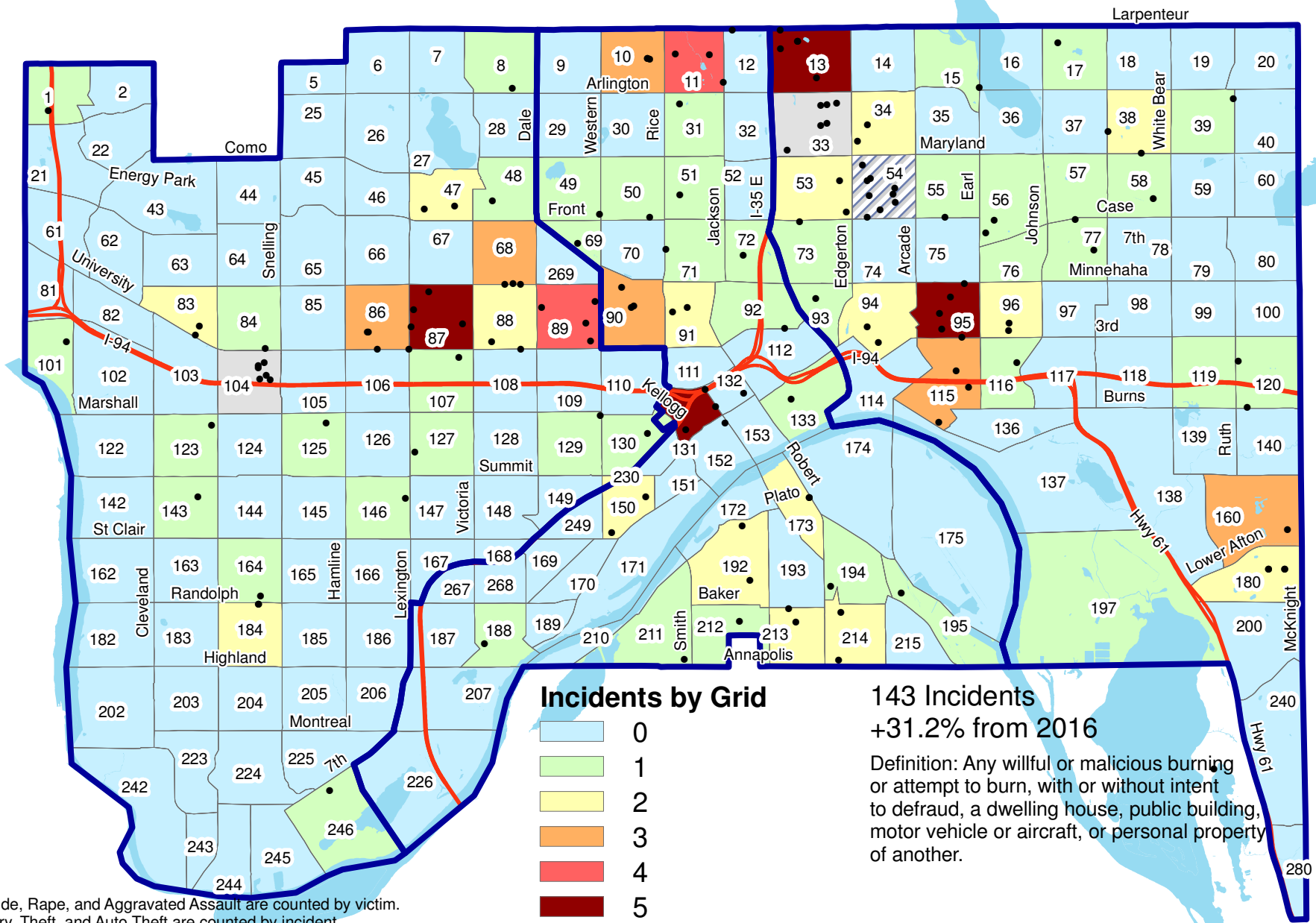

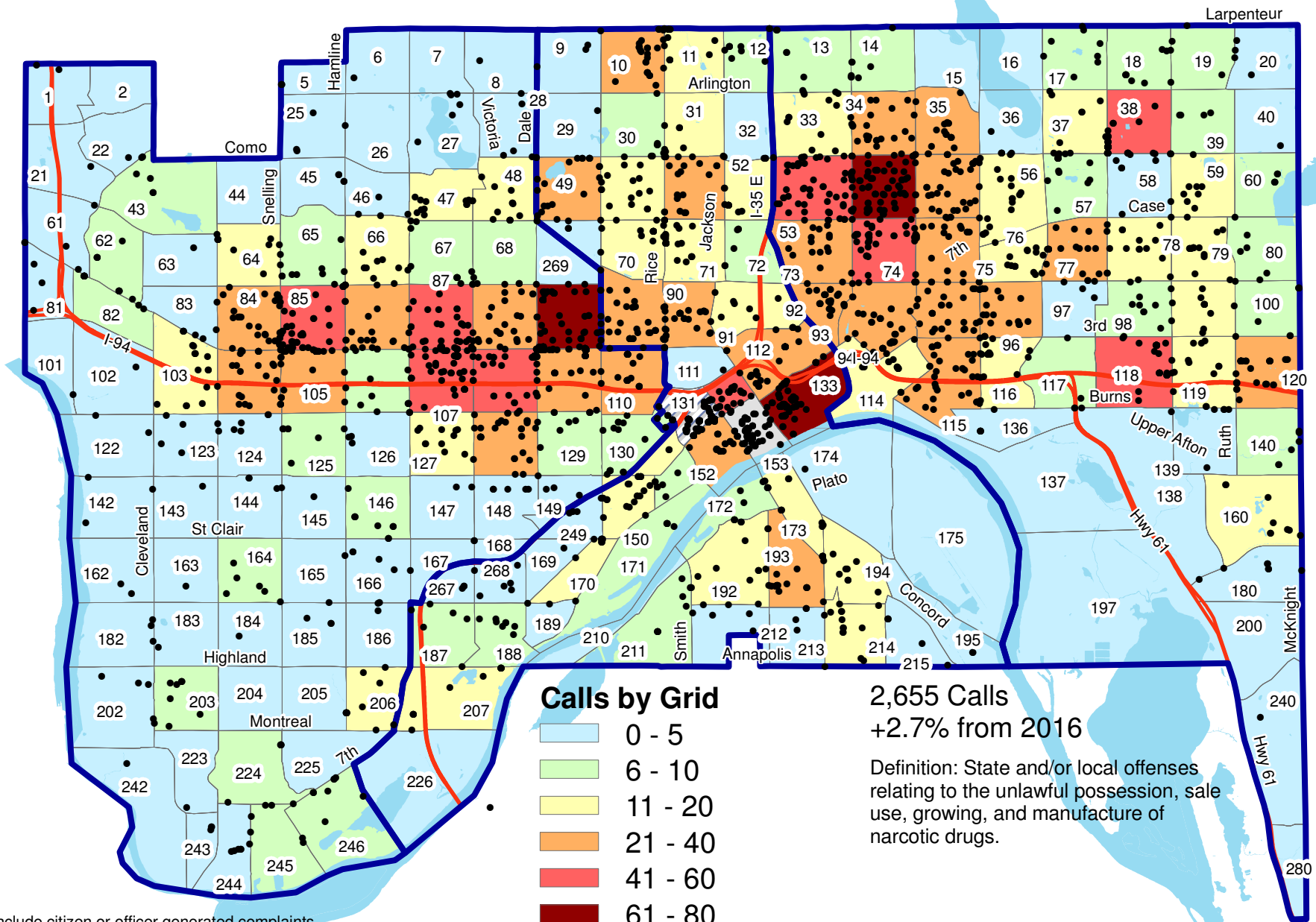

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City of Saint Paul: Narcotics Calls: 2017



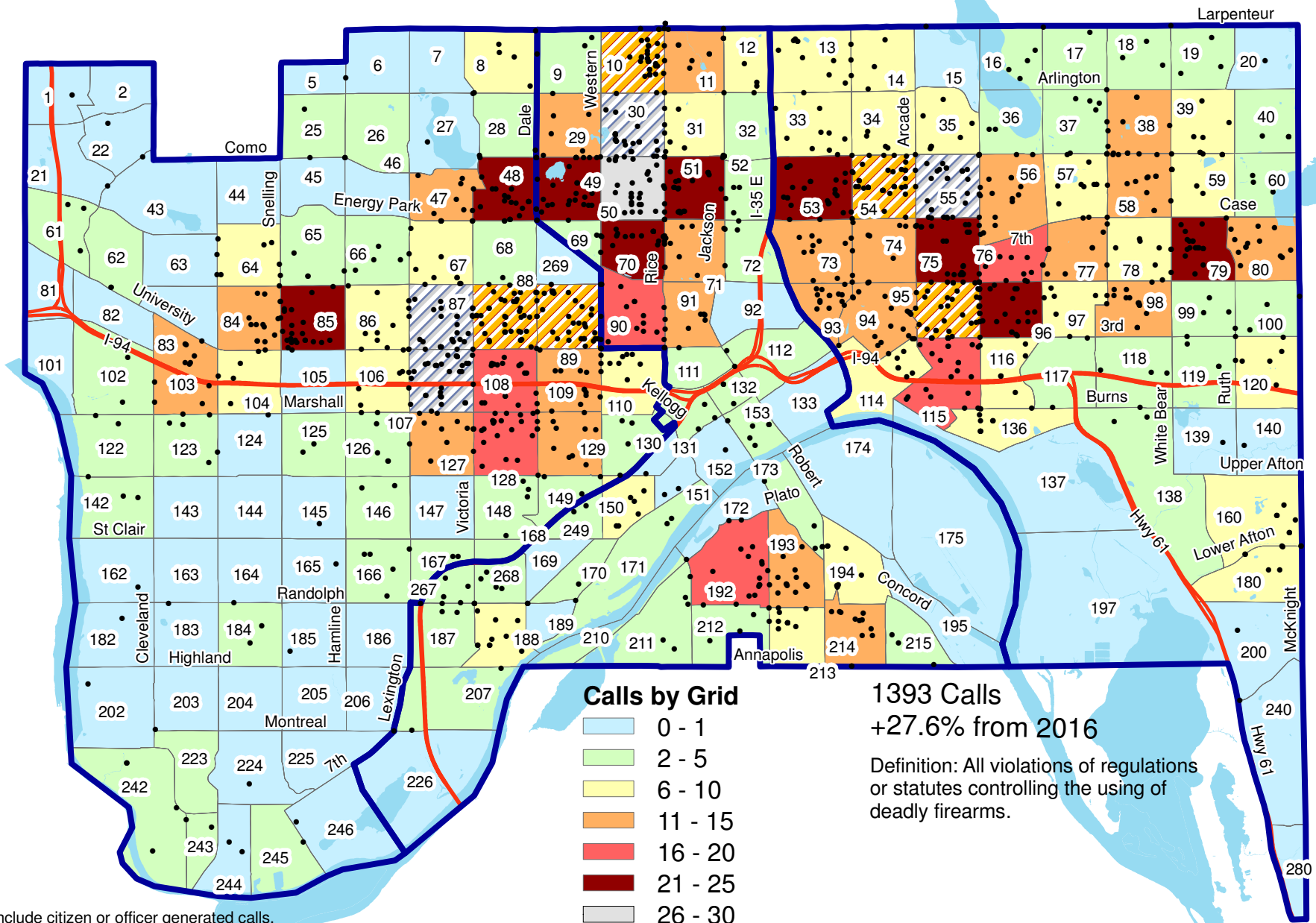

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City of Saint Paul: Weapon Discharge Calls: 2017

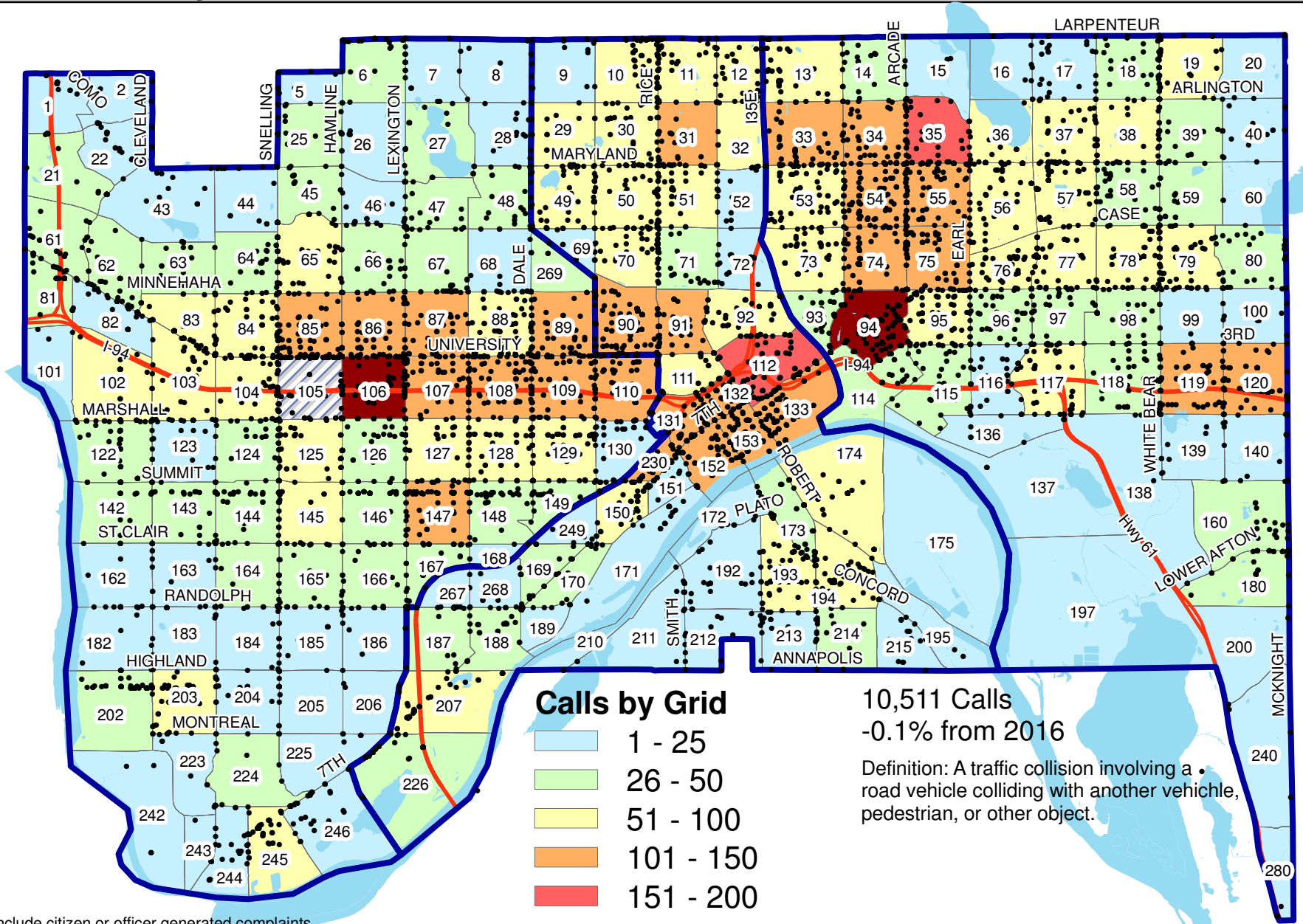

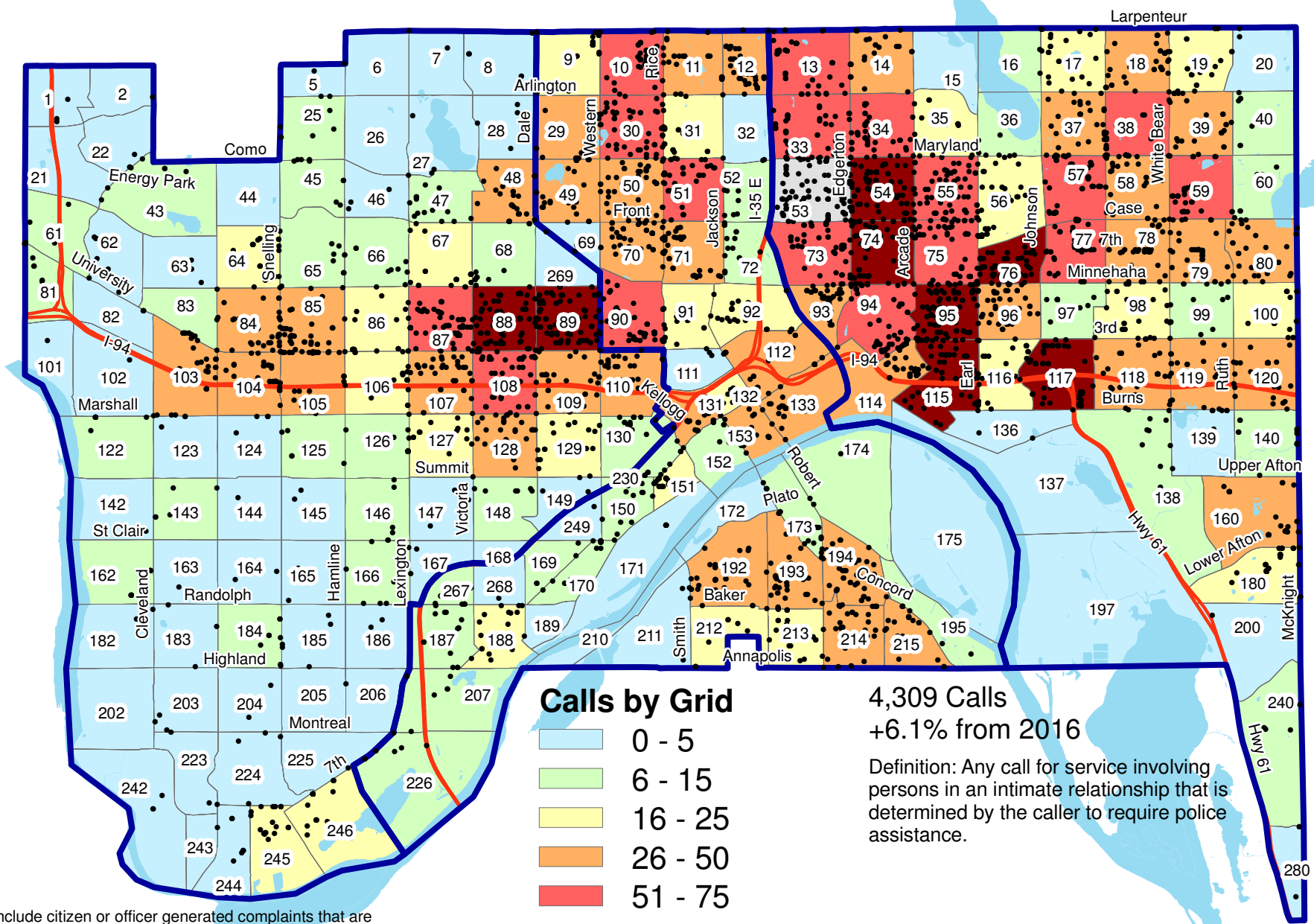

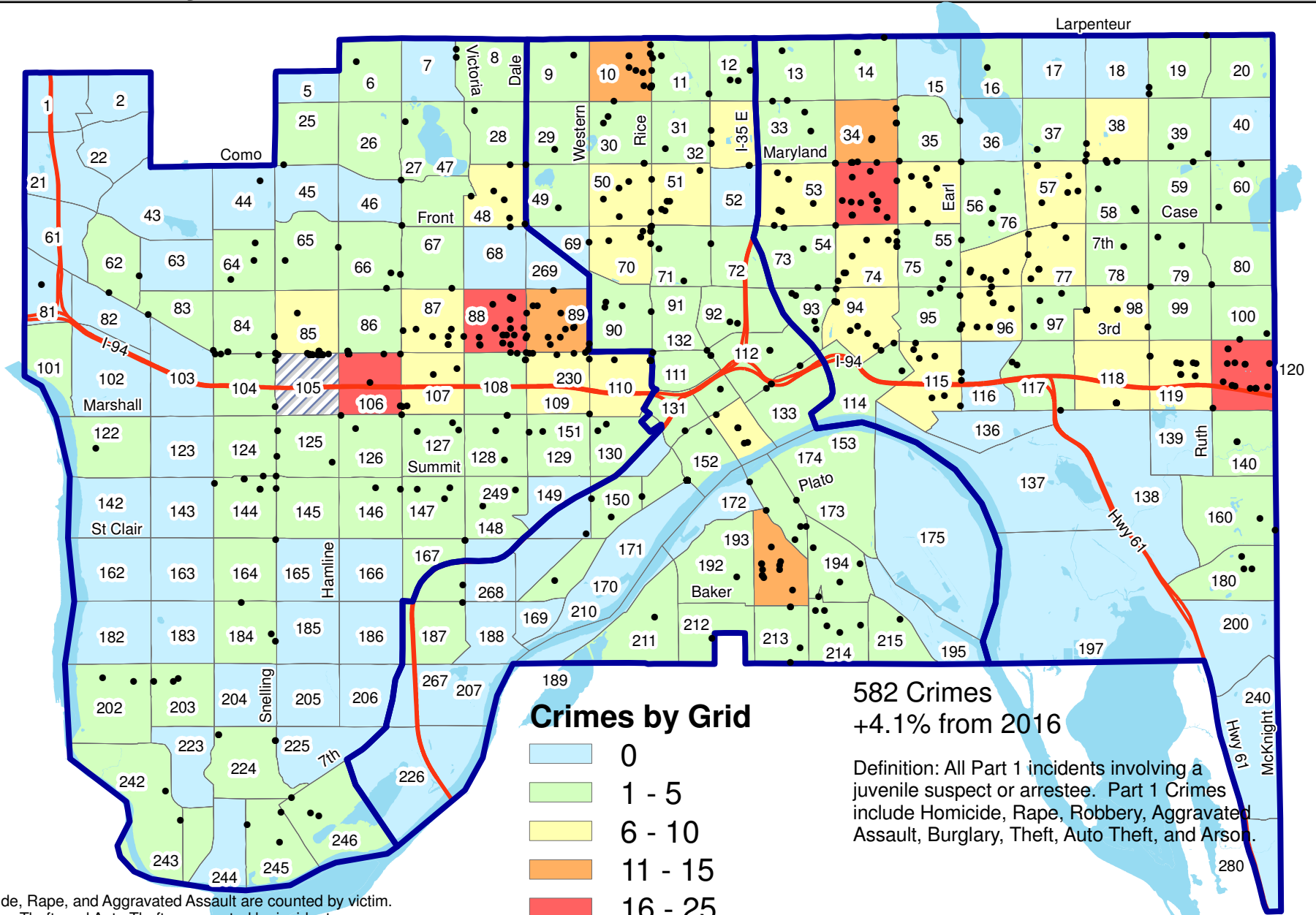
