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Reconstruction is Happening on the Griggs-Scheffer Paving Project Phase 1

What is happening?

The project will reconstruct streets in your neighborhood, improving the street pavement, curb and gutter, street lighting, sidewalks, water mains, and storm sewers.

When is it happening?

Your street will be under construction in 2020. The project will start work on Bayard and Watson Avenues in May. Additional information related to the schedule will be provided on the project webpage as it becomes known.

How will you be impacted?

Important Information

Driveway/Alley Access

There will be times when access to your driveway is not possible. Alley access may also be impacted at times; one entrance to the alley will always be accessible. You will receive details and information in advance of the temporary driveway or alley access restrictions.

Landscaping Items and Sprinkler Systems

If you have landscaping items in the boulevard right-of-way, please remove them prior to construction. Keep those items stored until the sodding and boulevard/sidewalk work has been completed. Any items left in the boulevard will be removed and disposed of by the contractor.

If you have an underground sprinkler system in the boulevard or public right-of-way, it is your responsibility to remove the system before the contractor begins work, repair the system if the contractor damages it, and replace the system after the contractor has completed placing sod in the boulevard or right-of-way. Where there is no sidewalk, the sprinkler system should be removed two-to-three feet behind the right-of-way or city property line.

Parking Restrictions

Parking restrictions may apply — please be mindful of signs posted. In the event of an emergency, please leave your address or contact number on the dash so we can have you move your car if necessary.

Recycling and Garbage Collection

Set materials close to the alley on your scheduled pick-up date.

Sod

Sod that is placed is guaranteed by the contractor for 30 days. You will receive an informational flyer on the care of your new sod.

Workday Schedule

The typical workday is 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. There may be occasions when contractors will need to work after 6:00 p.m. or on weekends.
